This role requires clinical precision, patient education, and compassionate support in a fast-paced physician’s office. This role is part-time.

### **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Prepare and administer IV infusions to patients, as prescribed by the physician
- Establish and maintain IV access; ensure patients are safe to receive their therapy prior to administration
- Monitor patients during and after infusions for adverse reactions
- Follow all infusion guidelines and safety protocols throughout the treatment process
- Obtain and document vitals, treatments, observations, and patient responses accurately in the EMR
- Educate patients and caregivers on infusion therapy and potential side effects
- Coordinate with the physician and office staff to ensure seamless patient care
- Maintain inventory of infusion supplies and medications
- Adhere to infection control and safety protocols in a clinical office environment
