Winter has arrived with a “deep flurry” in one day in Cache Valley. Not quite what we were expecting for a winter, but every bit of snow and rain helps our aquifer. Please send prayers, good vibes, dances, whatever you wish, to impact our water reserves in the mountains and sub-surface. We can use everyone’s mustard seed being exercised. That one storm increased our yearly water from 64% to 76% we’re still far below, but everything helps. As I said in a previous letter, water will be a constant theme this year.

In city planning news, we’ve applied for a grant to create a city Master Parks and Trails Plan. We’ll know in March or April if we get the grant. If it’s secured, we’ll be striving for resident participation to create a vision of what and how Hyde Park City should develop its parks and trails. Please watch for notices for public input.

You may have noticed stop signs on 700 East and 450 North, and a new four-way stop to be revealed on 400 East and 450 North. Our safety committee has taken the challenge to help reduce speeds and improve safety for pedestrians. Please watch and be aware of the signs. They will be revealed soon on 400 East and 450 North. Message From Chief Goodrich

With a warmer winter, snow and ice have not been a focal point for motorists. However other hazards are still on the road. Within the last month, several incidents have been reported where impatient drivers have proceeded through an intersection occupied with students against the direction of our crossing guards. Our crossing guards play a critical role in helping our students remain safe as they walk or bike to school. As a reminder, the biggest threat to our students and crossing guards are from vehicles turning left or right. If you are in a hurry, consider taking an alternate route and avoiding the crosswalks at the start and end of school.

With the new elementary and middle schools being built in Hyde Park, we have need for several more crossing guards.
