TOPIC: Trees



Don't forget to keep the trees trimmed that hang over a sidewalk or into the street. Keep trees trimmed back from the sidewalk to an imaginary line extending straight up from each side edge of the sidewalk to a height of eight feet. Also keep trees trimmed from above the road to a height so emergency vehicles can move down the street without interference (imagine a big firetruck needing emergency access). Don't forget about tree branches that could block visibility to signs such as stop signs or other regulating signs.

North Park Police Department

Over the last several weeks the police department has fielded several concerns from the community regarding speeding motorists on streets in the city. The following streets seem to be where the majority of complaints come from: 100 N 1100 E, north and south traffic along 700 and 900 E, as well as the Hyde Park Canyon road.

As a response, NPPD officers have been more visible in these areas and in some instances, have pulled motorists over for traveling over double the speed limit. We can all do our part to help to keep our streets safe by simply slowing down. Traveling at a lower speed can mean the difference between colliding with a sudden obstacle in your path (child, bike, ball, tree branch, etc.) or stopping in time and avoiding an accident.

HYDE PARK CITY COUNCIL MID-TERM VACANCY

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of a Midterm City Council Vacancy in Hyde Park, Utah. Any person interested in serving as a City Council member and meeting the following eligibility and residency requirements is hereby invited to complete an application. The appointed City Council member will serve through the vacated term of Council member Atkinson ending January 1, 2028.

Eligibility and Residency Requirements:

- 1) Candidate must be a registered voter of Hyde Park City.
- 2) Candidates must have resided in Hyde Park City for the previous 12 consecutive months.
- 3) Candidate must not be declared mentally incompetent by a court of law.
- 4) Candidate must not have been convicted of a felony treason, or a crime against the elective franchise unless the right to hold elective office has been restored.
