Reflect

Initiating & Planning

Research and understand a problem

Empathize: What big idea or issue listed above interests you most? Why?

Who does it impact? Why does it matter?

Define: What problem are you trying to solve? What information do you need? What limitations and materials do you have?

Ideate and generate potential solutions

There are NO bad ideas at this point in the process. Note down all your ideas (you never know what might come in handy later!). You may want to use a bigger writing space like a white board, notebook paper, or a digital tool.

Performing & Recording

Select an option and develop a prototype

Make sure to record your ideas (pictures, videos, written documentation, etc).

Test the prototype

Try it out! Identify the strengths and challenges of the prototype. Failure is an option and a great learning opportunity. Keep track of it, even if (especially if!) it doesn't work like you planned. This will help you in the next step.

Analyzing & Interpreting

Evaluate and revise the prototype

What can you add/change to your prototype to make it more successful, easier to use, or more effective?

Communicating

Communicate the solution

Share what you have created (or attempted to create) with an audience, including your teacher and classmates. Consider reaching out to people in the community you identified in the Initiating & Planning stage of the process; they will have the best, most authentic feedback. You can also share with E2.
