


TECHNICAL SEQUENCE

Level 5 - Ascending Slurs




Ascending Slurs - Open


- 1** "Hammer" and hold down the second finger so that you hear the E note without playing the string in the right hand.
Make sure the second note of the slur is rhythmically accurate.




- 2** Open to 2nd Finger Slur - Strings 1-6



- 3** Open to 1st Finger Slur - Strings 1-6



- 4** Open to 3rd Finger Slur - Strings 1-6



- 5** Open to 4th Finger Slur - Strings 1-6



Ascending Slurs - Closed

6 1st to 2nd Finger Slur - Strings 1-6
