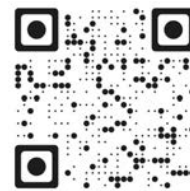

Level 5 - Descending Slurs



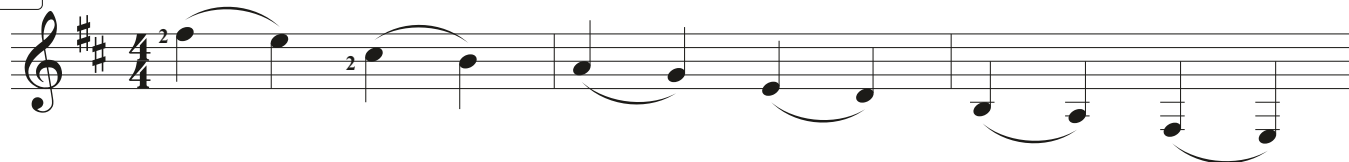
Descending Slurs: Open (Ending on an Open String)

"Pull-offs" or descending slurs occur when we pluck a fretted note then pull the left hand finger down and away at a 45-degree angle to hear the second pitch without rearticulating the string in the right hand.

1 2nd Finger to Open Slur - String 1

4 3rd Finger to Open Slur - Strings 1-6

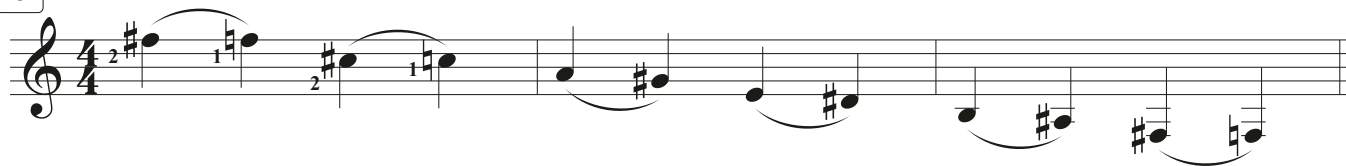


5 4th Finger to Open Slur - Strings 1-6

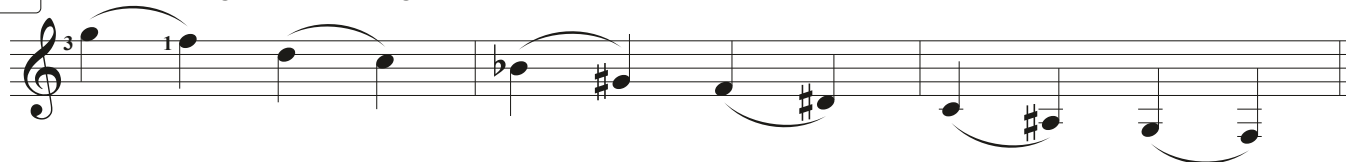


Descending Slurs - Closed (Ending on a Fretted Note)

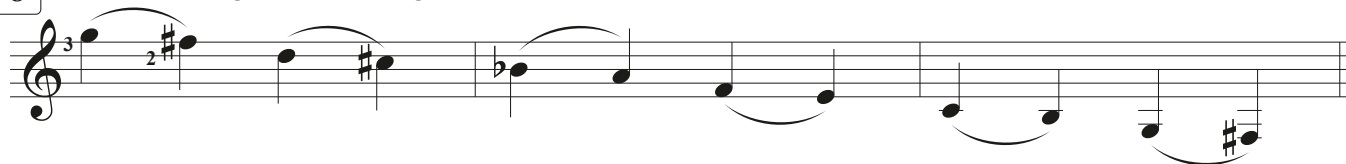
6 2nd to 1st Finger Slurs - Strings 1-6



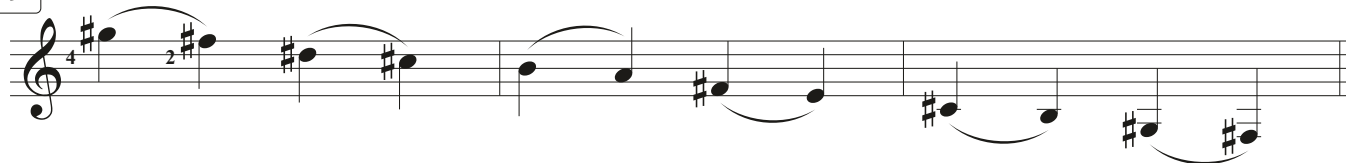
7 3rd to 1st Finger Slurs - Strings 1-6
