FROM THE MEETINGS



JANUARY

- Richard Betts spoke about the new H & VMA magazine in regards to ordering a hard copy of it. As advertised, the Group's annual June Rally will focus on the 80th year since the popular Little Grey Fergie's production. So I thought I'd share a few pointers on the little treasure, courtesy Mr Google.

- It's an iconic 20hp lightweight and versatile tractor designed by UK's Harry Ferguson and manufactured between 1946 and 1956.
- The grey colour was chosen as it was the cheapest post-WWII paint.
- The Fergie featured a 3-point linkage which connected implements directly to the tractor via hydraulics, increasing stability and manoeuvrability.
- Over 500,000 units were built, including petrol and diesel models.
- It's officially known as the Little Grey Fergie (Ferguson TE20) – the TE20 being for Tractor, England, 20hp.
