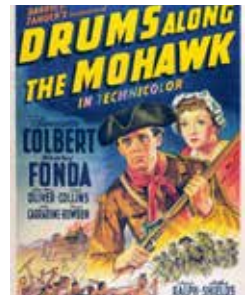

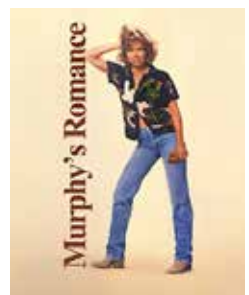

The story, told through alternating timelines, is a darkly humorous and twisty domestic thriller that explores themes of justice, redemption, and the consequences of gossip, as Elsie’s quiet life is upended by a curious child and renewed police interest.

*Hills like White Elephants* by Ernest Hemingway

*Hills like White Elephants* is a 1927 Ernest Hemingway short story about an American couple at a Spanish train station discussing an unwanted pregnancy, heavily implied to be an abortion, though the word is never used. The story uses sparse dialogue and symbolism (like the hills resembling white elephants) to reveal the couple’s strained relationship, the man’s self-centered desire to maintain his carefree lifestyle, and the girl’s (Jig’s) internal conflict and growing realization of their incompatibility. It exemplifies Hemingway’s “Iceberg Theory,” where the true meaning lies beneath the surface of the conversation.

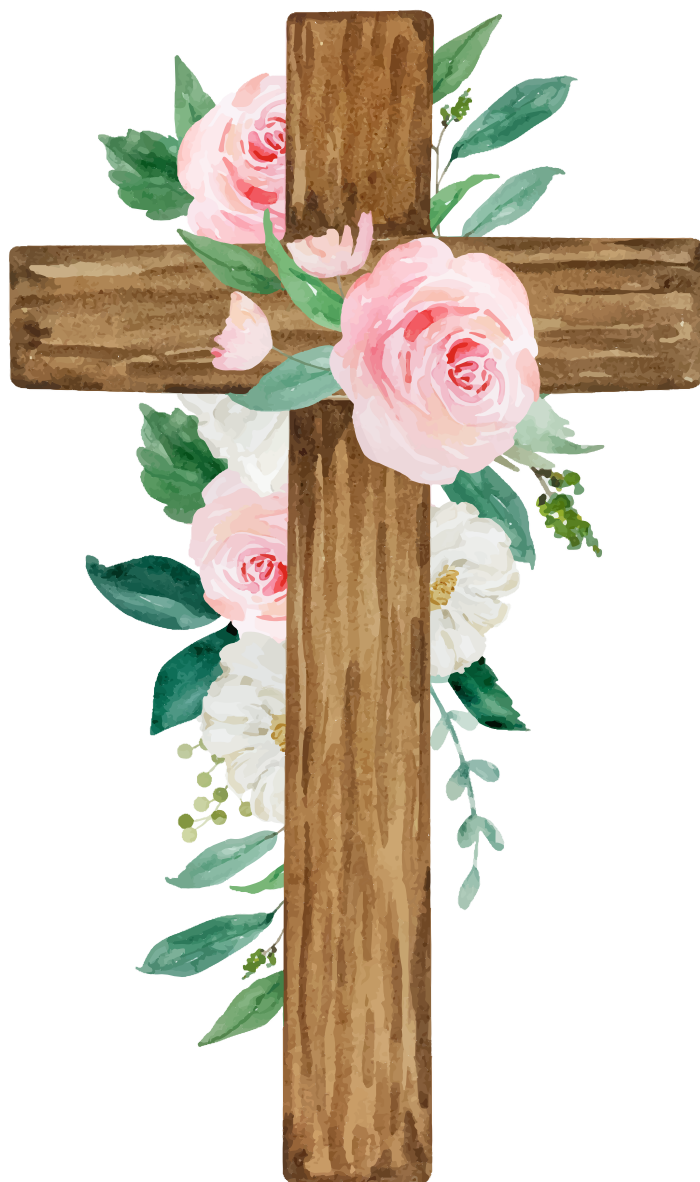
