A Letter from Fr. Kennell | Confirmation & Restored Order

Dear Parish Family & Friends,

As you may know, Bishop Wack has called every parish in our Diocese to implement the restored order of the Sacraments of Initiation by Fall 2028. This means our children will receive the Sacraments in their original, traditional sequence—Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist—bringing them into the fullness of the Holy Spirit's grace earlier in their lives.

Here at St. John the Evangelist, we will be making this transition gradually over the next three years so that families, catechists, and students can be well-prepared for this important change.

Our Parish Plan

- Fall 2025: Our current 9th graders will be Confirmed as previously scheduled.
- **2025/26 school year:** Students currently in 6th-8th grade will prepare for Confirmation, to be celebrated on September 26th, 2026.
 - Note that a parent info meeting will be held this Sunday (8/24) at 5pm in the Church for this year's program.
- 2026/27 school year: Students then in 4th-6th grade will prepare for Confirmation (date TBD).
- 2027/28 school year: Students then in 2nd-4th grade will prepare for Confirmation (date TBD).

May the Lord, who has begun this good work in us, bring it to completion.
