Know before you go



You must show a valid Spalding County ID, or a permit issued by Public Works to use Spalding County Collection Centers.



Attendants are not required to unload trash from your vehicle, however if you require assistance, please see the attendant



Commercial dumping and rental property/ foreclosure cleanouts are considered commercial waste

Hours of Operation

All centers including the Bulky Collection Center at Akin Collection Center are open Saturday's from 7am-1pm.

All centers are CLOSED Sunday, Wednesday, and ALL Local, State, and Federal Holidays

Items Accepted at Collection Centers

- **10 bags of household garbage**
- **Cardboard (must be broken down flat)**
- **Aluminum Cans (loose, not bagged)**
- **Recyclable items**
 - Plastic marked HDPE #1 & #2
 - Paper (No soiled, waxed or metallic paper)
 - Aluminum cans & foil pans (clean)
- **Yard debris**
 - Limited space only at Carver Rd Collection Center
- **Scrap Metal**
 - Appliances must have refrigerant removed
 - Tanks (propane/helium/etc) must have valve removed or at least 2 large holes
 - NO dishwashers or items made from mostly plastic.

Items Not Taken at Collection Centers

- Tires
 - Contact a local tire recycling company
- Construction & demolition materials
 - Wood, Sheetrock, Shingles, Carpet, Large Yard Debris, Etc.
 - These items may be taken to the Shoal Creek Landfill at 575 Shoal Creek Rd

Permits

Temporary Permit

- If you are new to Spalding County & have not had your Driver's License changed to show your current Address, you can go to the Public Works Office at 1515 Williamson Rd to apply for a temporary 30-day permit
- You must show a rental contract, mortgage, or closing papers, your current driver's license and Tag #'s to qualify

Permits

Permanent Permit

- PLEASE NOTE:
 - This permit will not be given to anyone with a Spalding County Driver's License.
 - This permit is not given to alleviate having to show your Driver's License.
- If you own property in Spalding County, but live in a different county or state and will not have a Spalding County Driver's License
 - You must show a rental contract, mortgage, or closing papers, your current driver's license, and license of resident under your care, and Tag #'s to qualify
- If you live in a different County or State but will be taking garbage for a Spalding County resident who cannot take their own.
 - You must show a rental contract, mortgage, or closing papers, your current driver's license, and license of resident under your care, and Tag #'s to qualify
