Spalding County Board of Commissioners Adopts Full Rollback Rate to Lower Property Taxes for 2025

Spalding County, GA — The Spalding County Board of Commissioners will consider adopting the full rollback millage rate for the 2025 tax year, delivering meaningful property tax relief to residents across the county. This decision reflects the Board's ongoing commitment to fiscal responsibility and its dedication to supporting citizens amid rising costs of living and economic challenges.

The approved millage rate of 15.256 mills represents no increase over the rollback rate, ensuring that General Fund property taxes will remain flat despite increases in property values. By accepting the full rollback rate, the County is choosing not to collect additional revenue that would otherwise result from higher property assessments.

Leadership Perspective

"This rollback reflects our ongoing efforts to be fiscally responsible while easing the financial burden on our residents," said Board of Commission Chair Clay Davis. "We are proud to take this step toward making Spalding County more affordable for families, seniors, and property owners across our community. Our goal is to ensure that rising property values do not translate into higher taxes for our citizens."
