## ANNUAL MEETING - NOTICE TO MEMBERS

The Annual Meeting of the Members is scheduled for May 20, 2026. The meeting will begin at 6:30 PM and is being held at Sierra Central Credit Union HQ, 1351 Harter Pkwy, Yuba City, CA.

The Sierra Central Board of Directors have appointed a Nomination Committee comprised of Sean Minard, Diane Myers, and Tib Belza.

The nomination of incumbent Baldev Johal and Devin Barber to each serve 3 year terms on the Board of Directors and the nomination of Mike Hudson to serve a 3 year term on the Supervisory Committee were accepted and approved by the Board of Directors on Monday, December 1, 2025.

Board of Directors and/or Supervisory Committee volunteers donate over 40 hours per month in reviewing credit union documents, attending committee meetings, attending monthly Board of Directors meetings and/or quarterly Supervisory Committee meetings.

If you were not selected by the Nomination Committee and still wish to be considered for an available position, you may petition to be on the ballot by obtaining 100 signatures from Sierra Central Members in good standing. The petition with the required signatures, along with your resume and your letter of interest expressing your willingness to serve if elected as a credit union volunteer, must be presented in person to the Board of Directors on Monday, February 23, 2026 between 4:30 PM and 5:00 PM. The location for the accepting petitions will be 1351 Harter Parkway, Yuba City, CA 95993, in the Kennedy Executive Board Room.

At 5:00 PM on February 23, 2026, the Board of Directors will officially close the nomination process and after such time no other petitions will be accepted for nomination.
