First Admission Round for Enrollment in the First Year of Undergraduate Studies Academic Year 2025/2026

The Faculty of Liberal Arts and Sciences (FLAS) announces the first round of admissions for undergraduate studies for the academic year 2025/2026.

Applications are invited from prospective students for the following majors: New Political Science, Cross-Cultural Linguistics, Digital Humanities, Media Studies and Journalism, Art History, Social Theory and Sociological Research

Total number of available places: 40

All documentation must be submitted electronically.

ENROLLMENT PROCESS AND REQUIREMENTS

To apply, candidates must complete the following steps:

- 1. Fill in the application form at: https://flas.mojo.education/register
- 2. Submit the required documents and a motivation letter
- 3. Complete the entrance examination, which includes:
 - An interview
 - An English language placement test (unless a valid certificate is provided)

Required documents

Applicants must upload scanned copies of the following documents to their personal account:

- Passport or national ID
- Certificate of Basic General Secondary Education
- Academic transcript (grades)
- Proof of English language proficiency (B2 or higher)*

IELTS – minimum overall score 5.5 (no section below 5.0) **TOEFL iBT** – minimum score 72

FCE / PET - minimum score 160

CAE - any score

Duolingo English Test - minimum score 100

Unified State Exam (ΕΓ3) – minimum score 90 (English)

If an applicant does not provide proof of English proficiency, they will be required to take the FLAS English placement test during the entrance exam period.

Motivation letter

A motivation letter is part of the entrance exam. It should be uploaded to the candidate's account along with other documents. A motivation letter is a specially written text in which the applicant explains their educational goals, their vision for their professional future, and why they wish to study at FLAS. The letter should be written in English and be 2000-2500 characters long.

Evaluation Criteria (max 30 points):

- The applicant clearly states their educational objectives, which are realistic and can be achieved by studying at FLAS (15 points).
- The text is well-structured, logical, and free from clichés, excessive pathos, and generalities (10 points).

^{*}Accepted English language certificates:

• The text adheres strictly to the specified length (5 points).

Entrance examination

Applicants will be invited to participate in an online entrance examination, which includes:

- A personal interview
- An English language placement test (if applicable)

The exact schedule of entrance exams will be communicated individually to each applicant after document submission.

TUITION AND FEES

- 1. The total cost of studies consists of two mandatory components:
 - Annual tuition fee of 2,500 euros (covering two semesters). This amount is fixed and will remain unchanged throughout the full duration of undergraduate studies.
 - Annual institutional fee of 2,500 euros (covering two semesters). This amount includes academic and institutional support throughout the duration of studies, including programme development, tutoring, library and digital tools access, administrative and logistical support.
- 2. Both domestic and international students pay the same tuition and institutional fees and have equal rights and obligations during their studies.
- 3. Students may choose an installment plan for paying tuition and institutional fees. Details regarding payment schedules and installment periods will be provided to each student upon enrollment.
