

Project update

- During August The Pines Wind Farm team continued to meet with neighbours to the proposal site.
- The wind farm site includes around 250 proposed wind turbines within parts of the Gurnang, Vulcan and Mount David State Forests, as well as additional turbines on neighbouring properties.
- Landowners who own a house within 3.5 km of a wind turbine are eligible to receive neighbour payments.
- Participating in the Nearby Neighbour Program is an opportunity for landowners to diversify their income for 35 years.
- There is no requirement for landowners to sign a non-disclosure agreement to join the Nearby Neighbour Program and you can still object to the project.
- Anyone who joins the Nearby Neighbour Program in 2025 will receive a \$5,000 sign-on payment.

- The installation of three 160m wind monitoring masts, located in State Forests, will be carried out over the coming months.
- Bird and bat surveys are continuing as the first element of the wind farm environmental impact assessment. Additional assessments will begin as the wind farm proposal progresses.

Electricity bill credit

Residents of the Oberon Local Government Area, and the suburbs of Triangle Flat, Bald Ridge, Abercrombie River, Trunkey Creek, Arkell, Hobbys Yards, Caloola and Rockley are eligible for a \$100 electricity bill credit per year from now until construction.

The program will increase to \$250 per year plus CPI from construction for the life of the project.
