Round 4 Sponsorship closing 28 February 2026

The project has now awarded a total of \$75,000 in funding to local groups, clubs, schools and organisations under The Pines Wind Farm Early sponsorship program.

There is \$50,000 in funding available each year across two rounds. Organisations can apply for \$1,000 to \$5,000 in funding per round.

Electricity Bill Credit - Submit your 2026 bill

Residents of the Oberon Local Government Area, and the suburbs of Triangle Flat, Bald Ridge, Abercrombie River, Trunkey Creek, Arkell, Hobbys Yards, Caloola and Rockley are eligible for a \$100 electricity bill credit per year from now until construction.

The program will increase to \$250 per year plus CPI from construction for the life of the project.
