Project design in 2026

- We are currently developing a revised wind turbine layout within the Gurnang, Mount David and Vulcan State Forests, as well as on neighbouring private properties.
- Our engineers have begun the process of designing wind turbine infrastructure within the project area, including access tracks and hardstand areas.
- The design will incorporate input from site neighbours regarding setbacks.
- Transport routes to the site for turbine components and construction traffic are under assessment.
- The revised turbine layout will be used for detailed environmental assessments and will be included in the Scoping Report to be submitted to the Department of Planning, Infrastructure and Environment during 2026.

\$100 Electricity bill credit - Submit your application for 2026

Residents of the Oberon Local Government Area, and the suburbs of Triangle Flat, Bald Ridge, Abercrombie River, Trunkey Creek, Arkell, Hobbys Yards, Caloola and Rockley are eligible for a \$100 electricity bill credit per year from now until construction.

The program will increase to \$250 per year plus CPI from construction for the life of the project.
