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Acknowledgement of Country

TagEnergy and Stromlo Energy respectfully acknowledge the Traditional Custodians of the lands where we live and work. We acknowledge and celebrate their ongoing connection to the land and waters. 1. About the Program

1.1. Introduction

Sponsorship of local groups, clubs, schools and organisations during the Investigations phase and Planning and Approvals phase of The Pines Wind Farm project is a valuable way to contribute to local communities.

The Pines Wind Farm will provide financial support for a range of sponsorship opportunities that benefit local communities. This support is open to community purposes and needs, including health and social welfare, safety, environmental, educational, youth projects, sport and recreation, culture, the arts, economic development and tourism.

The following guidelines are designed to assist groups, clubs, schools and organisations who wish to apply for sponsorship funding during the initial phase of The Pines Wind Farm. Groups located in the areas around the project are invited to apply. When applications are assessed there will be a preference for local groups and projects.

Local groups, clubs, schools and organisations located in the areas around the project are invited to apply for funding. Organisations and groups are eligible for \$1,000 to \$5,000 in funding per round.

1.2. Funding Rounds

The Pines Wind Farm Early sponsorship program is operating during the Investigations phase and Planning and Approvals phase of The Pines Wind Farm project. There is \$50,000 per year available in funding, over two funding rounds.

ROUND 1 Applications close 28 February
 Total funds available: \$25,000
 Successful applicants notified by 31 March

ROUND 2 Applications closed 31 August
 Total funds available: \$25,000
 Successful applicants notified by 30 September

1.3. Eligibility

Applicants must meet our eligibility for funding:

- Local community organisations including not-for-profit organisations and other groups, clubs or schools.
- The funding will provide benefit or services to communities that surround The Pines Wind Farm.

The following are not eligible for sponsorship:

- Political organisations or campaigns.
- Religious activities.
- Repayment of debts and loans.
- Applications seeking retrospective funding i.e. for costs already incurred.
- Applications in support of, or to cover the costs of alcohol, drugs, gambling or any illegal or unethical activities.

Organisations must be operating in:

- The suburbs of Abercrombie River, Arkell, Bald Ridge, Caloola, Hobbys Yards, Rockley, Triangle Flat, Trunkey Creek
- Or in the Oberon Local Government Area.

1.4. Assessment Criteria

Applications will be assessed based on the following criteria.

- How the initiative benefits the local community.
- How the initiative provides benefit to the broader community beyond the organisation/initiative being funded.
- The timing of the initiative.
- Proximity to The Pines Wind Farm proposal site.

2. How to Apply

2.1. Submitting an application

There are two ways to apply for the sponsorship program:

All applications will receive an acknowledgement of lodgement via email.

2.2. Assessment of applications

Applications will be assessed by TagEnergy and Stromlo Energy who are members of The Pines Wind Farm team.

Projects which best meet the assessment criteria, within the available funding for that round, may be approved by The Pines Wind Farm team. It may not be possible to fund all applications.

Once applications have been assessed, notification will be sent via email advising of the outcome of all applications, both successful and unsuccessful.

2.3. Sponsorship Agreement

Successful applicants will be required to sign a sponsorship agreement that sets out the terms and conditions of the sponsorship including but not limited to:

- How the sponsorship funds are used.
- Use of Stromlo Energy, TagEnergy and The Pines Wind Farm logos and materials.
- Any agreed advertising.

2.4. Confidentiality

All applications are treated as public documents. Stromlo Energy, TagEnergy and The Pines Wind Farm may share the successful applicants' details on social media and its website.

These details include the name of the organisation and purpose of the sponsorship, photos of events or materials.

Should applicants not want details or components of their application made public, this should be stated clearly within the application.
