TagEnergy has committed to a \$5 million Legacy Project Fund which would see a major community project, or projects, delivered in the region.

To determine which projects will be progressed under the fund, we are establishing a Legacy Project Committee made up of community representatives from the Oberon and Bathurst Local Government Areas.

## How will the funding be allocated?

A Legacy Project Committee will be established to determine which projects will be progressed under the Legacy Project Fund. The committee will guide the investment of the fund, ensuring decisions reflect local priorities and aspirations.

## Is this fund different to the Community Benefit Fund?

Yes. The \$5 million Legacy Project Fund is in addition to The Pines Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund, which will be in effect for the operational life of project.

## What is the Legacy Project Committee?

To determine which projects will be progressed under the Legacy Project Fund, we will establish a Legacy Project Committee made up of community representatives from the Oberon and Bathurst Local Government Areas.

The role of the committee is to:

- 1 **Advise** on the Terms of Reference for the Legacy Project Fund, to determine how projects will be assessed for funding.
- 2 **Review** funding submissions and recommend a project, or projects, that will enhance the communities of Black Springs, Burruga, Oberon, and Trunkey Creek.
- 3 **Determine** which projects will be sustainable over the long term, benefit communities most impacted by the wind farm and have significant positive impact on the greater region.

To be eligible to join the committee, applicants need to demonstrate:

Current or previous experience or involvement with a board, community project, community group or not-for-profit organisation. ✓

That you reside, study, work or have a meaningful connection to the Oberon or Bathurst LGAs. ✓

Availability to attend monthly committee meetings. ✓

That you can support the delivery of a major project or projects funded by The Pines Wind Farm (you do not need to support the project or sign a waiver of any rights in relation to the approval of the wind farm). ✓
