## Exam Fees & Extra Costs

Exam entry fees are payable in term 2 for the NZAMD Tap, Jazz and Contemporary; and BBO or RAD Ballet exams. Extra lessons are given prior to exams and will be charged to your bill. (See fees for 2 lessons per week).

Our annual production takes place at the end of term 4 and this involves charges for your costume/s as well as extra rehearsals which requires commitment.

All fees are payable in advance and based on an 8 week term - any extra lessons are courtesy of the dance school. There are no classes on public holidays. This includes Easter, Labour weekend and King's Birthday weekend. Lessons cannot be conducted during dancing exams, this is taken into account when fees are set.

Our preferred method of payment is internet banking. There is EFTPOS available at the Studio.

- No discounts or refunds given for lessons missed or incomplete terms for any reason, be it illness, holiday, injury.
- All new pupils are required to register before taking a class.
- We do not accept casual pupils as this disrupts the teaching schedule. There is a waiting list in some classes and you will be liable for payment until you give notice of withdrawal. All classes are dependent on adequate numbers.
