WKND'26 CODE OF CONDUCT

1. To maintain accountability and ensure safety, no student is allowed to be alone with the opposite gender.
2. Alcohol, non-prescription drugs, tobacco products, firearms, fireworks, knives, or weapons of any kind are strictly prohibited.
3. All student medications must be checked in and registered with our nurse on-site.
4. We ask students to respect all adults, students, and church/camp property. We also ask students to avoid language or actions that are inappropriate or hurtful to others.
5. We ask that all clothing be modest, without inappropriate language or images. Students will be asked to change if their clothing does not meet these guidelines.
6. Students are expected to participate in all scheduled activities and stay within designated areas unless otherwise directed.
7. We have a zero-tolerance policy for physical violence and bullying of any kind. Parents will be called, and you will be sent home immediately.
8. While we strive to support each student's unique needs, if we determine that a student's behavioral or mental health, or medical needs exceed what we can provide, parents will be contacted and required to pick up their child.

We reserve the right to send a student home due to any infraction on this list.
