SUMMER CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT

Here at City Students, we are about joining God in transforming students into passionate followers of Jesus. The boundaries listed below help us ensure that this value is met.

1. To maintain accountability and ensure safety, no student is allowed to be alone with the opposite gender.
2. Alcohol, non-prescription drugs, tobacco products, firearms, fireworks, knives, or weapons of any kind are strictly prohibited.
3. All student medications must be checked in and registered with our nurse on-site.
4. We ask students to respect all adults, students, and church/camp property. We also ask students to avoid language or actions that are inappropriate or hurtful to others.
5. We ask that all clothing be modest, without inappropriate language or images. Swim guidelines for all students include a dark-colored shirt and shorts. Students will be asked to change if their clothing does not meet these guidelines.
6. Students are expected to participate in all scheduled activities and stay within designated camp areas unless otherwise directed.
7. We have a zero-tolerance policy for physical violence and bullying of any kind. Parents will be called and you will be sent home immediately.
8. While we strive to support each student's unique needs, if we determine that a student's behavioral or mental health, or medical needs exceed what we can provide, parents will be contacted and required to pick up their child.

Any violation to this code of conduct will result in parents being contacted and required to pick up their child. In the event that a child needs to go home, the parent/guardian will be responsible for arranging transportation from Camp Eagle Sky, in Piedmont, MO. We allow 24 hours for parents to make the necessary arrangements for their child to be picked up. City Students and COTC is not responsible for providing this transportation.
