Faithfulness: I commit to showing up — with my time, my energy, and my gifts. I understand that my team depends on me, and I will communicate proactively with my leaders when I can't. *(Romans 12:6-8, Hebrews 10:24-25)*

Generosity: I commit to growing in generosity — using my time, talent, and treasure to make a difference in my church, my community, and the world God loves. I believe generosity is a fruit of spiritual growth and a compelling and powerful way to live. *(2 Corinthians 9:7, Luke 21:1-4)*

Alignment: I am open to and respectful of Echo's beliefs and values. I will honor what this church stands for, and I understand that the higher I go in leadership, the deeper that alignment needs to be. *(1 Corinthians 1:10)*

Echo's Beliefs

The Bible

We believe the Bible to be authoritative for all areas of faith and practice. It is inspired by God, written by people, and a source of wisdom and direction for those who meditate on it and apply it to their lives. (John 17:17, 2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter 1:20-21)

God

We believe in one God who unconditionally loves all people, regardless of their race, gender, or nationality. He eternally exists in three distinct persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19; John 1:14; Acts 5:3-4; 2 Corinthians 13:14)

Jesus Christ

We believe Jesus Christ is the perfect revelation of God to humankind. He is fully God and fully man. After voluntarily coming to earth and living a sinless life, He died on the cross as the substitute for humanity's sin. His resurrection from the grave affirms His victory over sin and death. (John 1:1-18; Romans 3:21-26; Philippians 2:5-8)

Humanity

We believe God created humans, both male and female, in His perfect image. However, because of sin, humanity is alienated from God. As a result, humans are incapable of being in a relationship with God based solely upon their effort. (Genesis 1:26-31; Romans 3:10-18; Ephesians 2:1-3)

Salvation

We believe that all who trust in Jesus Christ alone as their Lord and Savior will receive the forgiveness of sins and the free gift of eternal life. True life is only found in Christ. (John 3:16; Romans 8:28-39; 1 John 5:11-13)

The Holy Spirit

We believe the Holy Spirit indwells followers of Jesus at the point of salvation. He also equips them with spiritual gifts for serving others and guides them in the journey to become like Christ. (John 14:15-26; Acts 2:1-33; Galatians 5:16-23)

Marriage

We believe that God designed marriage to be a sacred relationship and the only place for sexual activity to take place. Biblical marriage is a lifelong covenant relationship between a man and a woman to the exclusion of all others. Because of our convictions about what the Bible teaches, we only perform weddings under these beliefs. (Matthew 19:6; Ephesians 5:31; Romans 1:26-27; 1 Corinthians 6:9)
