

SECRETARY'S DESK

IHPBA India is celebrating its Silver Jubilee in 2025 and on this occasion, I extend warm wishes to our members. Over several years, our association has grown and established itself as a scientifically committed group for the betterment of the science and practice of HPB surgery and allied disciplines in India.

National executive committee of the association has taken transformative steps for major expansion in the academic and training domain offered by IHPBA India. The number of HPB certificates courses increased from two to four per year. Another certificate course was

held outside India. We have also started HPB cadaver training courses two per year. Considering the increasing role of radiology in our speciality, a dedicated HPB Radiology course was added to the list of training courses and two such courses were held and one is upcoming. To help surgeons to navigate liver better, dedicated intra-operative ultrasound training courses were added and three such courses were held. In an effort to make a qualified HPB surgeon a complete HPB specialist, two hands on endoscopy programmes are added. Realising the importance of nurses in the speciality, a dedicated HPB nursing training program is designed and three such events were held and one is upcoming. 22 events and academic programs in a calendar year made IHPBA India one of the most vibrant HPB societies under the ambit of IHPBA Global.

International collaborations have also progressed in this Silver Jubilee year.

With Nepal societies, we are conducting HPB certificate courses and cadaveric courses. Collaboration with Singapore society has resulted in



tripartite two-day academic event at Singapore. 10 travel awards were provided for Indian surgeons for this event. One Indo UK and another India-Singapore training fellowship for younger surgeons from India were initiated. Two one-year long fellowships were instituted by IHPBA India exclusively for Nepal Surgeons. Four 3 months training fellowships were awarded for Indian surgeons for the advancement of skills from best centres in the country. 25 bursary awards were provided for the national conference. This exemplifies our commitment for training of the next generation HPB specialists in the country.

IHPBA India has entered into three long term memorandum of understanding for academic collaboration with industry partners which immensely helped us to improve the number of training programs while adhering to all the needed standards and compliance.

More than two hundred doctors newly availed membership in this year itself which signifies the growth of the association. We have also appointed an office secretary to streamline activities in these ever-increasing domains of our association. Modified website allows access for direct registration for courses and events. We have also shifted to complete online banking and completed financial audits.

I am sure that the coming years will witness more programs, events and partnerships which will surely help us to achieve better heights.

LIVER SUMMIT - 2024 & MID-TERM CONFERENCE OF IHPBA INDIAN CHAPTER

1st Liver Summit - 2024 and Mid-Term Meet IHPBA Indian Chapter was held in *Jaipur* on *13th - 14th September 2024*.

It was organized by **Dr Naimish N Mehta** at Mahatma Gandhi
University of Medical Sciences and
Technology, Jaipur in association
with the IHPBA (Indian Chapter).
The theme for this meet was

Transcending Boundaries: Art of Liver Surgery, Transplantation and Advances in Hepatology.

It was a two-day program with 500+ participants from across the country which involved specialists from various fields including HPB surgery, Liver transplantation, Hepatology, Anesthesia & Critical care and Interventional Radiology. The Organizing Committee diligently worked to curate a diverse scientific program from a galaxy of international and national speakers.



The scientific program included plenary lectures, engaging keynote addresses, debates, thought-provoking panel discussions, master video sessions, papers presentations, e-posters.

Topic highlights included: benign and malignant liver surgery; perioperative optimization (ICG-guided surgery, FLR augmentation, IR in portal hypertension); minimalaccess/robotic approaches and donor hepatectomy; focused transplant updates; evidencebased debates (CRLM vs LT, HCC strategies, and TIPSS vs LT in Budd-Chiari); anesthesia & critical care for LT; immunosuppression in complex settings; viral hepatitis updates; MASLD; ERAS; machine perfusion (HOPE); portal vein thrombosis; and post-hepatectomy liver failure.

Inaugural ceremony was graced by Smt Gayatri A Rathore, Principal Secretary Health and Family Welfare Department, Rajasthan as the Chief Guest. Dr M L Swarankar, Emeritus Chairperson MGUMST as Guest of Honor.

Amongst the other dignitaries present were Dr Vikas Chandra Swarankar Chairperson-cum Chancellor MGUMST, Dr Achal Gulati Vice-Chancellor MGUMST, Dr Puneet Dhar President IHPBA-Indian Chapter, Dr Biju Pottakkat, Secretary IHPBA-Indian Chapter.

Over 50 abstracts were received for various presentations, amongst which 10 trainees were given awards in different categories by expert panel of judges.



This meeting was successful due to strong academic participation and high-quality deliberations by experts across HPB speciality.



HPB CERTIFICATE COURSE

This course was organised by the Centre of Excellence for Digestive Diseases at Amrita Hospital, Faridabad on 15th - 19th January 2025.

The HPB Certificate Course was organized by **Dr Jaya Agarwal**. It is a focused academic program designed to provide a comprehensive overview and advanced insights into Hepato-Pancreato-Biliary (HPB) Surgery and Liver Transplantation.

The course brings together renowned national experts to deliver high-yield lectures, casebased discussions, and hands-on training across five immersive days.

THE COURSE WAS THEMED AS **Liver Mastery:** Segmental anatomy, liver imaging, parenchymal transection, and IOUS.

Liver Transplant & Portal

Hypertension: Donor-recipient evaluation, organ retrieval, implantation, immunology, and portal hypertensive surgery.

Pancreas Power: Pancreatic necrosis, chronic pancreatitis, Whipple procedure, and NETs.

Biliary Brief: Complex gallbladder cases, biliary injury management, and gallbladder cancer.

Cutting Edge Conversations: Research writing, medicolegal practices, and surgical career guidance.



FIRST HPB RADIOLOGY COURSE

HPB Radiology Course, a first of its kind to be conducted in the country was organized by the departments of Surgical Gastroenterology and Radio-diagnosis at AIIMS Bhubaneswar on 30th - 31st January 2025.

The importance of radiological interpretation in the diagnosis, prognosis, surgical planning and postoperative follow up cannot be overemphasized in the present era of ever-evolving complex HPB diseases and their complex treatment options. This course was apt to address the same to the HPB surgeons and trainees. 25 delegates including HPB surgical trainees and faculties from all over the country were selected for the course, which spanned three sessions of online basics of HPB radiology to two days of physical HPB radiological extravaganza. The lectures were given by eminent specialists in the field of **HPB and liver transplant surgery** and **liver transplant, HPB and interventional radiology** from across the country. The sessions saw a focused one-on-one interactions of the delegates with the speakers. The lectures were followed by a live session of various interventional procedures conducted by the interventional radiologists.



Under the leadership of

Dr Bramhadatta Pattnaik, the
course successfully culminated
in the in-depth understanding of
the complex HPB surgical
anatomy in the fields of

Ultrasonography, CT scan, MRI
as well as PET CT scan by the
delegates who left with a deep
understanding of the subject.



IHPBA CERTIFICATE COURSE

The Department of HPB Surgery,

Christian Medical College Vellore,
conducted the IHPBA Certificate

Course from the 3rd - 7th February

2025 at the newly started CMC

Ranipet campus.

This specialized course - organized by **Dr Ravish S Raju** - attracted approximately 45 delegates, offering a comprehensive learning experience in the rapidly evolving field of HPB surgery. The course was supported by 53 distinguished professionals, hailing from both India and abroad, all of whom possess extensive experience in **HPB surgery**, **liver transplantation**, and related subspecialties.



Throughout the 5-day program, delegates were exposed to cutting-edge practices, advancements and challenges in HPB surgery. Rather than theoretical knowledge, the emphasis was on daily practice and expert insight on pitfalls to avoid and how to manage complications. The attraction remained the training module in HPB Radiology where participants applied the knowledge they received and answered a quiz of around 50 HPB radiology images under the guidance of HPB Surgeons and Radiologists. The **Vascular Anastomosis**Workshop on day I inspired the young surgeons and the feedback was positive.



IHPBA HANDS-ON CADAVERIC COURSE

IHPBA India, in collaboration with Shri Balaji Institute of Medical Science, Raipur conducted a twoday Hands-On Cadaveric Workshop on 18th - 19th May 2025.

Designed to advance surgical expertise in complex hepatobiliary and pancreatic procedures, the program attracted surgeons from across the region. Day one featured an intensive lecture series, where expert faculty delivered focused sessions supported by minimally edited surgical videos.

dissection, providing
participants with a strong
theoretical foundation.

Organising Secretary.






Topics included liver, pancreas and biliary imaging, transplant evaluation, interventional radiology, and the management of complications. Registration was limited to 50 delegates.
