ABOUT *the* ORGANIZATION

The Philadelphia Cultural Fund was established in 1991 as a 501(c)(3) organization to provide funds to enhance the cultural life and vitality of the City of Philadelphia and its residents.

PCF is managed by a professional philanthropy staff, with governance provided by a board of directors (BOD) comprised of arts leaders, community members, and representatives named by the Mayor and City Council President.

Each year, PCF provides operating support to Philadelphia-based arts and culture organizations. These grants are made from an allocation to PCF from the City budget.

The grants support organizations dedicated to the creation, education, preservation, exhibition, and presentation of a variety of arts and culture disciplines.

PCF is committed to removing barriers to grant applications, especially for small, community-based arts organizations that are traditionally considered ineligible for funding support.

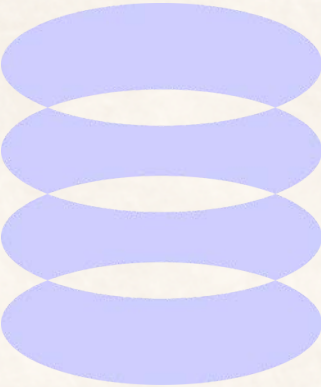
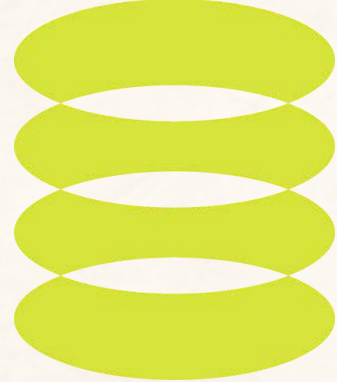

It's hard to believe a year has passed since I joined The Philadelphia Cultural Fund. Reflecting on this time, I am filled with immense pride and gratitude for the incredible journey we've shared. In the past year, we've made significant strides in supporting and nurturing the vibrant arts and culture communities in our city. We distributed vital grants, enabling numerous artists and cultural organizations to thrive, even in challenging times.

Through our advocacy efforts, we were able to secure an additional \$500,000 from the Mid-Year Transfer ordinance in the City's FY24 Budget. Our engagement initiatives have expanded, our trust-based philanthropic impact reaching more diverse communities and ensuring that the arts are accessible to all Philadelphians in all ten districts.

As a creative community organizer at heart, I have centered that lens in my leadership at PCF, fostering new relationships and deepening them among staff, board members, grantees, peer panelists, council members, and community stakeholders.

One of the most rewarding aspects of this year has been collaborating with such a dedicated team and passionate community partners. Their unwavering commitment and creativity have been truly inspiring.

Together, we've launched new systems, innovative programs, and events such as:

- **Submittable:** A new, accessible grant platform system we've adopted into our programming.
- **PCF Pulse:** A monthly newsletter filled with arts and culture resources and PCF updates for anyone to subscribe to via our website.
- **Peer Panel Advisory:** A cohort of advisors that helped inform our new application process, including rubric, eligibility, and more. To help lead both the Advisory and Pilot processes, we partnered with AFE Strategies.
- **Pilot Peer Panel:** A cohort of panelists who received training to review new applications and steward PCF dollars.
- **Grantee Info Sessions:** We collaborated with CultureWorks to facilitate an in-person session and Movimiento Administradores de Arte en Pensilvania (MAAP) to facilitate a virtual session held in both English and Spanish.
- **Meet & Greet:** We partnered with Norris Square Neighborhood Project for first-time recipients of the FY24 cohort to gather at Las Parcelas Garden.
- **New Visual Identity:** With great excitement and honor, we introduced our reimagined logo, brand colors, and visual identity. This milestone represents more than just a cosmetic change; it signifies our commitment to evolution, innovation, and relevance in an ever-changing world. Through thoughtful collaboration and creative vision with our Brand Designer, Sarah Johnson, and Web Designers at Butterland, we crafted a fresh and dynamic identity that reflects the vibrancy, diversity, and vitality of Philadelphia's cultural landscape.
- **Archives & Preservation:** We partnered with Embassy Interactive and other independent artists to archive all of our programs and events through videography and photography, reflected on our website, Vimeo account, and this annual report.
- **Annual Report:** This is our second annual report that now reflects our new brand and programmatic impact.

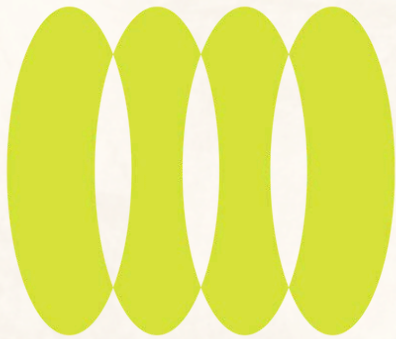

ABOUT *the* GRANT PROGRAM



The Philadelphia Cultural Fund awards grants to hundreds of arts & culture programs each year—reaching all corners of this city we love.

Grant applications are reviewed through a transparent and robust process. This operational structure enhances the integrity of the grant-making process and ensures continuity across mayoral administrations in terms of PCF to grantee relationships and funding practices.

This year PCF piloted a new panel program to award first time applicants. Returning organizations completed a streamlined application via Submittable.

The Philadelphia Cultural Fund's FY24 budget is resourced through the City of Philadelphia's 2024 budget and supplemented by donations. The Art & Culture Grants provide much-needed general operating funds to small and mid-sized arts organizations that are dedicated to creating, preserving and/or exhibiting visual, literary and performing arts, architecture, science, history and the humanities.



ART & CULTURE GRANTEEES

The 2024 Art & Culture Grantees have average budgets of \$1.5M.
The average grant amount being \$12,180.

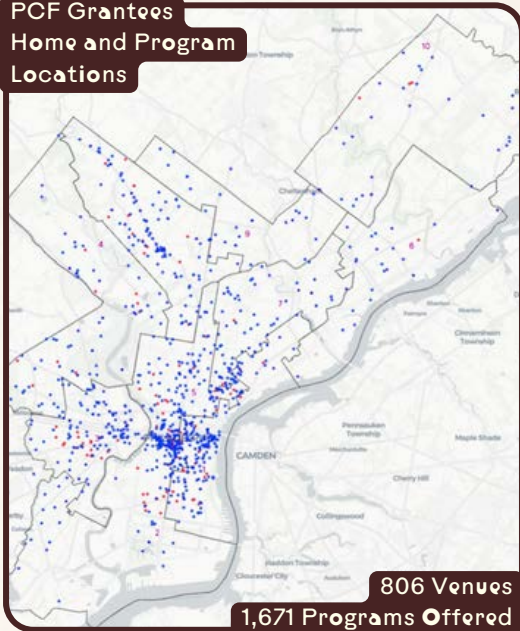

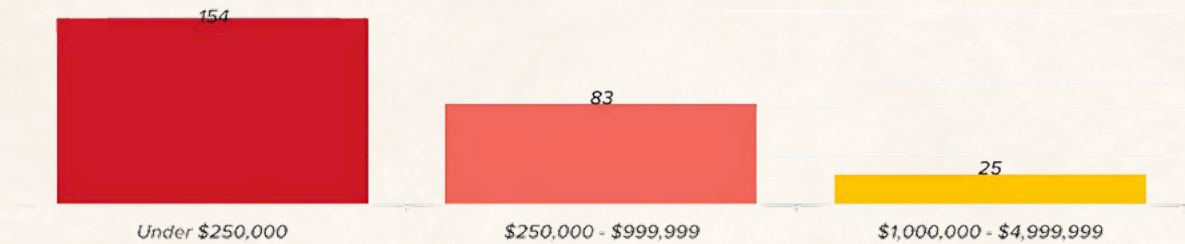

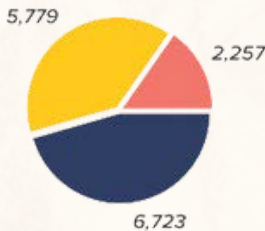

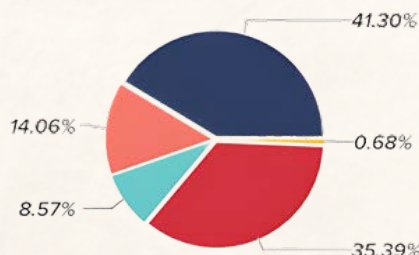
Direct Expenditures

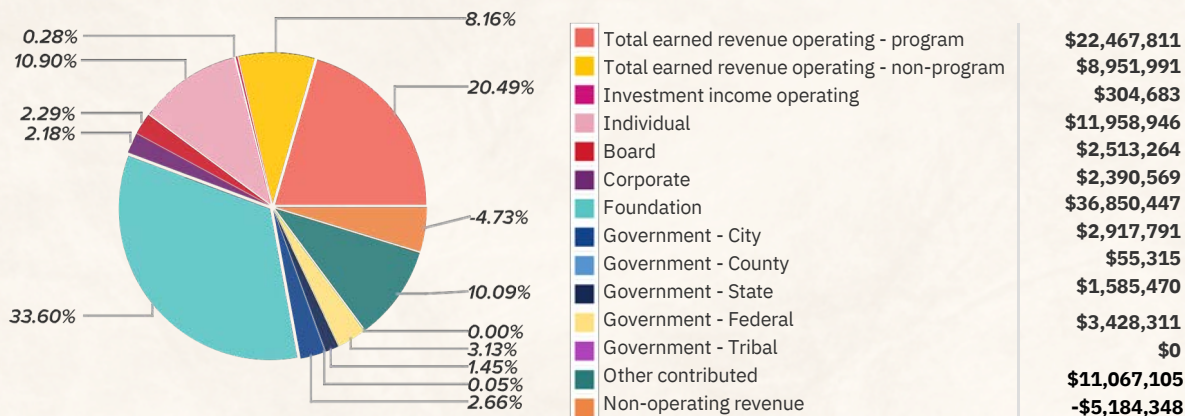

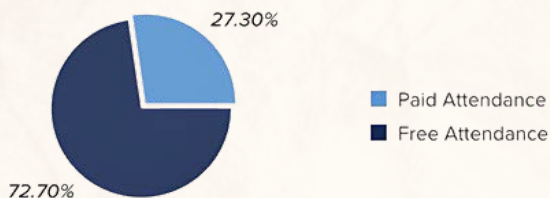
Attendance and Participation

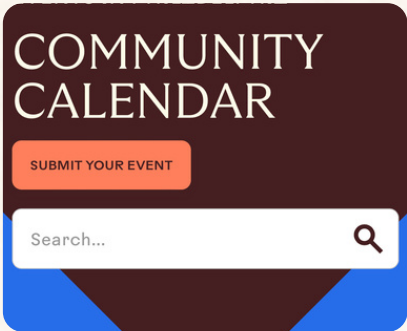
