

2026 Scholarship Application

The annual West Orange Junior Service League Scholarships are based on academic achievement, good citizenship, and financial need. Each scholarship is \$3,000 to a four year university (Bachelor's Degree) or \$1,500 towards a two-year college (AA Degree or Technical School).

To be eligible, you must:

- Be a senior at Dr. Phillips, Horizon, Ocoee, Olympia, West Orange, or Windermere High School
- Be a student in good standing who has applied for and is awaiting acceptance, or has been accepted, for further education at a public college, public university, or public trade school in the state of Florida.**
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a scale of 4.0
- Display traits of good citizenship
- · Indicate involvement in school or community activities
- Personal Statements will be run through a plagiarism detector.

**Any applicant or recipient who at any time receives the University of Florida Machen Florida Opportunity Scholarship (MFOS) or any similar fully paid scholarship, at any college, university, or trade school, will be disqualified from receiving WOJSL Scholarship. If this occurs, the applicant or recipient must notify the WOJSL immediately. Though conflicting with the WOSL Process, these awards are excellent opportunities and the WOJSL congratulates any student who receives it.

Applications must include:

- Completed application which includes Applicant Profile and Personal Statement.
- Two letters of recommendation, one school-based reference (counselor or teacher) and one community-based reference.
- A copy of the first two pages of parent's most recent Federal Income Tax Return or a copy of the FAFSA Submission Summary including the Student Aid Index (SAI).
- Official High School Transcript (official copy from guidance office is acceptable).
