This poll surveyed 1,299 registered voters via online panel from January 28, 2026 to January 29, 2026. Results were weighted by gender, age, race, education, and partisanship to match population demographics. The margin of error is ± 3.1 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

The "One Big Beautiful Bill Act" permanently extends individual income tax cuts and creates new tax exemptions for tips and overtime pay, while also increasing the Child Tax Credit. To offset these costs, the legislation repeals green energy tax credits for electric vehicles and requires stricter work requirements for welfare beneficiaries. The bill also establishes government-funded savings accounts for newborns and allocates \$150 billion in new funding for border security infrastructure.
