




Lifesaving health interventions supporting displaced communities around the globe.

A mother goes into labor in a field hospital surrounded by shellfire. A child in a transit camp fights a preventable infection. A young woman seeks help after trauma but finds none.

In conflict zones, settlements, migrant paths, and regions affected by climate disaster, complex health crises continuously threaten displaced communities.

These aren't isolated stories. They are daily realities for millions, especially women and girls, whose futures are deeply shaped by access to health care. But health is more than a basic need; it's the foundation for resilience, for restoring self-reliance, and for building stronger, more vibrant communities. These challenges demand more than emergency relief. They call for a compassionate way of delivering care that treats people not just as patients, but as whole human beings with the potential to thrive. Alight has been answering the call of medical response since 1978 – and we have no intention of stopping now.

We're rooted.

Even when others pull out, Alight is still delivering care, oftentimes emergent, in places like Sudan, the Somali Peninsula, and Rwanda.

We co-create.

From the first conversation to the final service, we design with, *not for*, our customers.

We go beyond clinic walls.

Bringing maternal care, mental health support, and nutrition services directly into communities, homes, and safe spaces.

We restore agency.

Through community-led systems and human-centered design, we give people the power to shape their own health futures.

- Empower women, adolescent girls and youth to access sexual and reproductive healthcare services with dignity, while fostering equality and rebuilding resilience in their lives and communities
- Train youth leaders and equip peer educators in displacement contexts

We walk with displaced communities not only to survive, but to rebuild lives of dignity, health, and hope.
