For over two decades, Alight has been a trusted humanitarian leader in Sudan, building strong relationships with communities and delivering lifesaving services to more than **5 million people**.

Alight is often the only source of medical care in remote regions.

Why Maternal Health? Why Now?

Today, Sudan is one the world's most severe humanitarian crises of continued conflict, famine, and instability in which mothers & newborns face the highest risk of death and disability:

- Sudan has a maternal mortality rate (MMR) of +25%.
 256 maternal deaths per every 1,000 births
- Hospitals and maternity wards have closed or been destroyed
- Displacement leaves pregnant women far from skilled care
- Newborns without access to emergency care often do not survive







With healthcare infrastructure collapsing and +11 million internally displaced Sudanese, the need for accessible, high-quality obstetric care has never been greater.

Alight's Comprehensive Emergency Obstetric and Newborn Care (CeMONC) centers are lifelines, providing services from antenatal care to emergency cesarean sections free of charge to the most vulnerable mothers and their babies.

CeMONC Operation

- State-of-the-art **CeMONC centers** in East Darfur, South Darfur and Gedarif
- Providing assisted deliveries, and newborn resuscitation
- Delivers antenatal and postnatal care, including essential medicines, diagnostics, and blood transfusions
- Trains healthcare workers and strengthens local health systems
- Runs community outreach programs to raise awareness of safe pregnancy care

East Darfur:

Faiza

When Faiza's local hospital closed and there was no safe place to give birth, she feared she would lose her baby. Faiza became the first to deliver at Alight's new CeMONC center in East Darfur, receiving expert care and a life-saving caesarean allowing her to cradle her healthy newborn.

Basma had already endured
devastating pregnancy losses.
With Alight's support in Gedarif,
her high-risk pregnancy resulted
in healthy quadruplets, turning
fear for the future into the love
of new life.

Left alone as her husband went to find work, Hassania worried she could not afford care and faced the terrifying thought of delivering without help. At Alight's Majok facility in South Darfur, she found free care, compassion, and continued antenatal support for her and her new baby.
