Conflict and hunger devastate millions.

Conflict Sudan's war has displaced millions; Ukraine enters its 4th winter of crisis; violence in the Somali Peninsula continues to drive families from their homes

Hunger In 67 countries approximately 319 million people are facing acute hunger; children under five are most at risk

Systems Collapsing With rapidly decreasing foreign aid funding, clinics, food supplies, and schools shutter overnight

Disproportionate Impact Women and children bear the heaviest burden

power to imagine **brighter futures.**

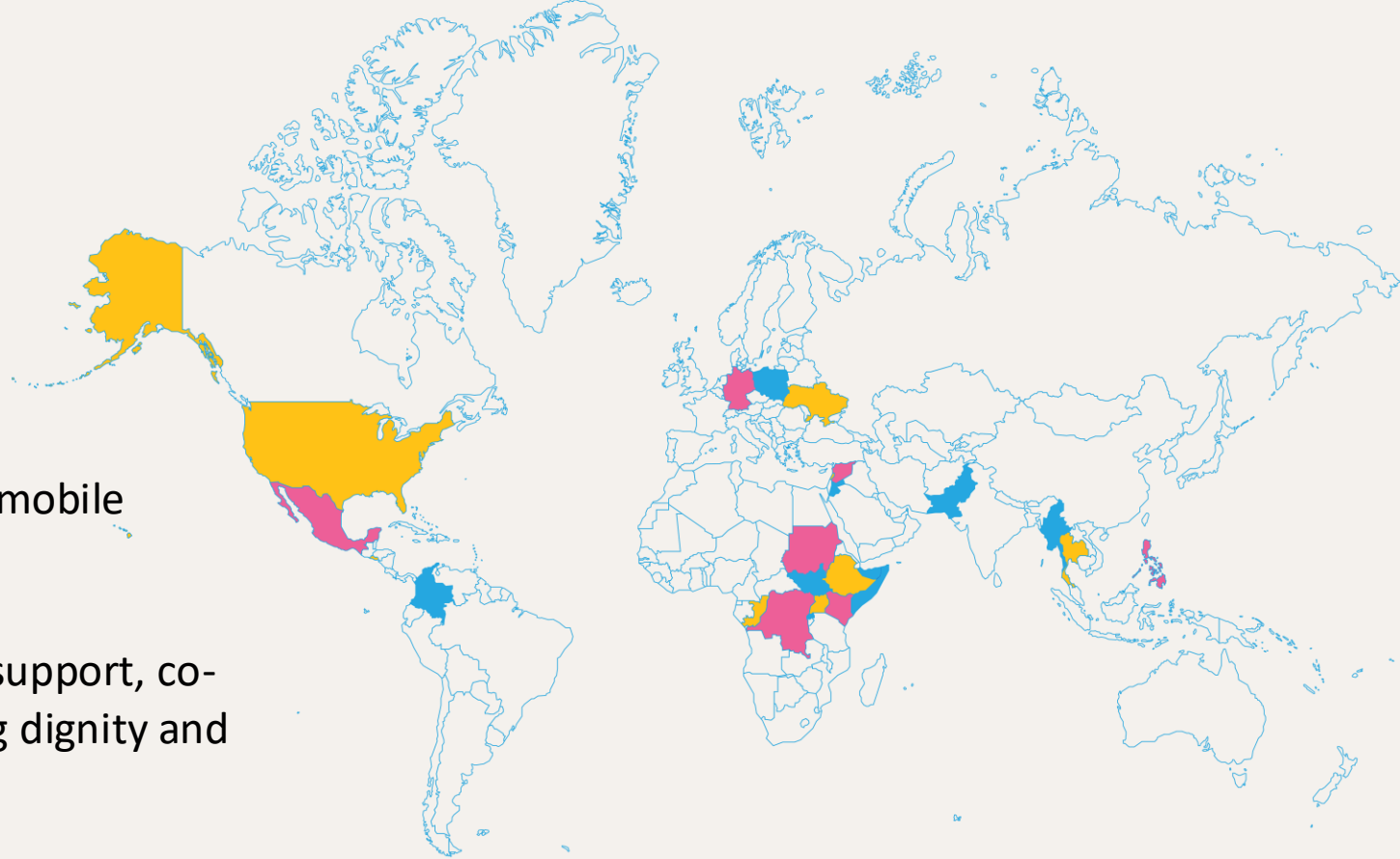
Where Alight Responds To Emergency

Sudan: Largest healthcare provider throughout war; mobile teams, cholera response, maternal health

Ukraine: Expanding mental health and psychosocial support, co-created with veterans and displaced families, ensuring dignity and healing amid continued conflict

Somali Peninsula: Nutrition, health, and water access for drought-affected and displaced families

Uganda: Emergency reception and protection for refugees fleeing across borders

Alight in Action.

Conflict Response

- **In Sudan,** Alight is the largest healthcare provider, running dozens of clinics across 5 states and reaching over 1.3 million people throughout war
- **In Ukraine,** Alight is delivering MHPSS to veterans, widows, and the elderly ensuring dignity, resilience, and healing
- **In Uganda,** Alight leads reception and transit centre operations that continue to host thousands of Congolese and South Sudanese refugees arriving monthly

Hunger Response

- **Across East Africa,** Alight runs stabilization centres for severely malnourished children. Each centre keeps hundreds of children under 5 alive every month
- **In the Somalia Peninsula,** Alight operates 16 health clinics and 1 mobile clinic, serving over 500,000 displaced people with healthcare, nutrition, and water
- **In the Somali Peninsula and Uganda,** Alight delivers urgent nutrition packages to mothers and children, reducing child malnutrition rates
