Proper Sorting Makes a Difference! (And It's The Law)

USE YOUR CONTAINERS TO SORT YOUR WASTE FOR:



- Compliance with California regulations: AB341, AB1826, and SB1383.
- Reduction in the amount of material going to the landfill. Nearly 6 million tons of food are discarded in California landfills annually. resulting in organic waste making up 18% of our landfilled waste.
- Reduction in greenhouse gas emissions. Anaerobic decomposition (decaying without the presence of oxygen) of organic materials in landfills produces methane, a greenhouse gas that contributes to climate change. Composting organic material captures carbon and reduces greenhouse gas emissions.

CALIFORNIA LAW (SB 1383) REQUIRES RECYCLING

AND COMPOSTING. All Multi-Family Residences, regardless of complex size, must sort RECYCLABLES & ORGANIC materials (including food scraps and food-soiled paper) out of the garbage.

Anything other than rain water is an illegal discharge in storm drains.


- To report suspicious discharges into a storm drain, call 9-1-1. The Milpitas Fire Department responds to reports of illegal dumping into storm drains.

Cardboard Collection Tips

Please remember to flatten cardboard boxes and cut larger pieces to 3' x 3' or smaller before placing them in your **blue Recyclables** container. If you have a container with a **yellow lid**, place the cardboard there.

This helps:



- Prevent blockage inside the container
- Keep drivers safe and the collection program efficient
