



MILPITAS RESIDENTIAL STREETS ARE SWEEPED TWICE A MONTH TO KEEP OUR NEIGHBORHOOD STREETS CLEAN AND STORM DRAINS OPEN

Please remember to move your vehicle on your street sweeping days. Vehicles left on the street will block the sweepers and prevent them from keeping our storm drains clean. This, in turn, pollutes our bay as storm drains flow directly to the bay.

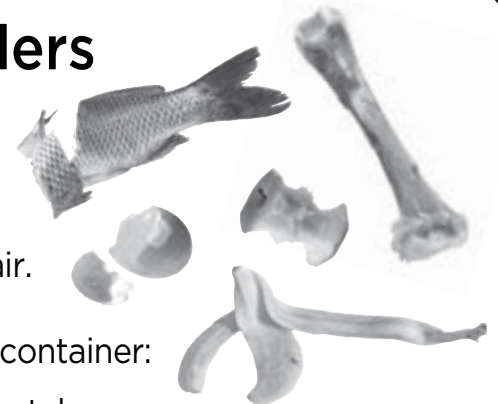
- For Parking Prohibited Street Sweeping Program Areas, follow the street sweeping hours on the posted signage.



When vehicles and other obstructions block the street, sweepers cannot remove debris against the curb.

Food Scraps Service Reminders

Californians send nearly 6 million tons of food scraps to landfills each year. This equals about 18 percent of all the material getting sent to our landfills. Putting food waste in the **brown food scraps** container ensures it goes to the right place and not the landfill, where it releases gases that pollute the air.



Remember the following when putting your food scraps in the food scraps container:

- Keep it Clean - Only food belongs in the food scraps container. Always take your food waste out of any packaging (like to go containers and salad bags) and either place it directly in your food scraps container, or...
- Use Clear Bags - Only clear bags are permitted for the sorting and collection of food scraps. Black, white, color, or opaque bags will be screened out as garbage
