

# Sorting Makes a Difference!



#### We thank you for your efforts!

Keep recyclable items out of the landfill through proper sorting. We know that recycling can be confusing, but some fine tuning will take your recycling to the next level. Recent contamination monitoring in Milpitas showed that these items are frequently placed in the wrong containers:



Cardboard



**Food Scraps** 

1. Cardboard – A lot of cardboard gets incorrectly thrown away in the garbage. To recycle *clean* cardboard, place it in the blue recyclables container. If you have a container with a yellow lid, place the cardboard there.

2. Brown Food Scraps –
Food scraps, coffee filters,
and tea bags are often
incorrectly thrown away in
the garbage and yard
trimmings. To ensure these
items get recycled, place
them in the brown food
scraps container.

# A WORD ABOUT CARDBOARD



Please remember to flatten cardboard and paper boxes and cut pieces down to 3' x 3' or smaller if they don't fit in the container.

#### This helps:

- Maximize space in the recyclables container
- Prevent blockage inside the container
- Keep drivers safe and the collection program efficient

#### Holiday Service Reminder

# **Service Updates**

There have been some recent changes regarding what's accepted in each waste stream. Keep the following in mind the next time you're sorting your waste:

### **Food-Soiled Paper Products**

Food-soiled paper, cardboard, and napkins no longer belong in the **brown food scraps** collection container. Please place these items in your gray garbage container from now on.



### **Clear Plastic Bags**

Clear plastic bags can now be recycled, but only if they're bagged together. Collect your clear plastic bags in another clear plastic bag, tie it, and place it in the **blue recyclables** container to ensure they get recycled. Un-bagged bags, colored bags, and other film plastics like bubble wrap and cling wrap will not be accepted and belong in the gray garbage container.

## **How Does My Business Properly Dispose of Hazardous Waste?**

Some small business owners in Santa Clara County may qualify for the Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG) Program. To see if your business qualifies, visit hhw.santaclaracounty.gov/drop-business-waste or scan the QR code.



#### **Right Size Your Service Levels!**

Overloaded containers lead to unsafe service conditions, potential litter entering our storm drains, illegal dumping, and damage to property and collection containers. If you find that any of your service containers tend to get overfilled before their collection days, please reach out to us so a representative can help adjust your service levels as needed.
