## Proper Sorting Makes a Difference! (And It's The Law)

USE YOUR CONTAINERS TO SORT YOUR WASTE FOR:

- **Compliance with California regulations:** AB341, AB1826, and SB1383.
- **Reduction in the amount of material going to the landfill.**

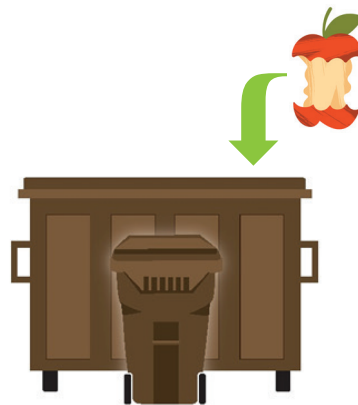
Nearly 6 million tons of food are discarded in California landfills annually, resulting in organic waste making up 18% of our landfilled waste.

- **Reduction in greenhouse gas emissions.** Anaerobic decomposition (decaying without the presence of oxygen) of organic materials in landfills produces methane, a greenhouse gas that contributes to climate change. Composting organic material captures carbon and reduces greenhouse gas emissions.

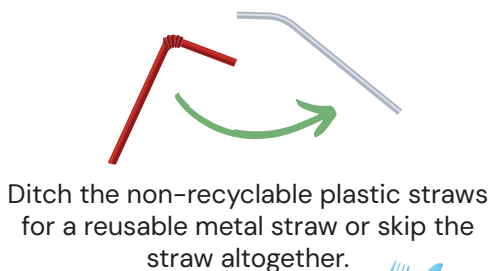

**CALIFORNIA LAW (SB 1383) REQUIRES RECYCLING AND COMPOSTING.** All Multi-Family Residences, regardless of complex size, **must sort RECYCLABLES & FOOD SCRAPS materials out of the garbage.**

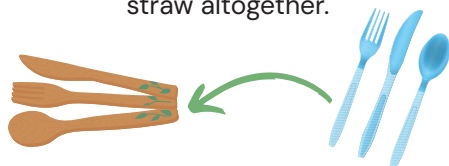

### Let's Talk Reusable Alternatives:



Ditch the non-recyclable plastic straws for a reusable metal straw or skip the straw altogether.



Plastic utensils are single-use, non-recyclable, and easily replaceable. Opt to bring travel utensils to events.

Plastic bottles can be recycled but the lifecycle of plastic is limited! Try switching to a reusable metal bottle.

## Cardboard Collection Tips

Please remember to flatten cardboard boxes and cut larger pieces to 3' x 3' or smaller before placing them in your **blue Recyclables** container. If you have a container with a **yellow lid**, place the cardboard there.

This helps:

- Maximize space in the container
- Prevent blockage inside the container
- Keep drivers safe and the collection program efficient
