



# MILPITAS RESIDENTIAL STREETS ARE SWEEPED TWICE A MONTH TO KEEP OUR NEIGHBORHOOD STREETS CLEAN AND STORM DRAINS OPEN

Please remember to **move your vehicle on your street sweeping days.**

**Vehicles parked on the street will block the sweepers** and prevent them from keeping our storm drains clean of litter and leaves.

**This pollutes our bay** as storm drains flow directly to the bay.

For Parking Prohibited Street Sweeping Program Areas, follow the street sweeping hours on the posted signage.

## Residential Curbside Collection of Special Items

### RECYCLE YOUR HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES AND USED MOTOR/COOKING OIL CURBSIDE - IT'S EASY!

#### CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF USED MOTOR OIL, COOKING OIL AND MOTOR OIL FILTERS:

- Contain used oil in sealed 1-gallon, screw-top containers and filters in a sealed zipper-lock style bag.
- **Please do not mix motor oil and cooking oil.** No other automotive liquids accepted.
- Place containers/bags on the curb (not in the gutter) next to (not inside) your Blue Recyclables Split Cart for collection.
- 2 gallons/1 bag collection limit per resident per week.

#### HOUSEHOLD BATTERY COLLECTION:

- Place household batteries in a clear plastic zipper-lock style bag.
- Tape the ends of all batteries (to reduce risk of electric discharge). No car batteries allowed.
- Place on top of (not inside) your Blue Recyclables Split Cart for collection.
