



MILPITAS RESIDENTIAL STREETS ARE SWEEPED TWICE A MONTH TO KEEP OUR NEIGHBORHOOD STREETS CLEAN AND STORM DRAINS OPEN

Please remember to **move your vehicle on your street sweeping days.**

Vehicles parked on the street will block the sweepers and prevent them from keeping our storm drains clean of litter and leaves.

This pollutes our bay as storm drains flow directly to the bay.

For Parking Prohibited Street Sweeping Program Areas, follow the street sweeping hours on the posted signage.

When vehicles and other obstructions block the street, sweepers cannot remove debris against the curb.

Food Scraps Service Reminders

Californians send nearly 6 million tons of food scraps to landfills each year — about 18% of all landfill waste. Putting food scraps in the **brown food scraps** container helps keep them out of landfills, where they release harmful gases that pollute the air.

When using the food scraps container, remember:

- **Keep it clean** - Only food belongs in the food scraps container. Remove all packaging, such as takeout containers and salad bags, before placing them in the container... OR
- **Use clear bags only** - Food scraps may be placed directly in the container or in clear bags. Black, white, or opaque bags will be treated as garbage.
