



MILPITAS RESIDENTIAL STREETS ARE SWEEPED TWICE A MONTH TO KEEP OUR NEIGHBORHOOD STREETS CLEAN AND STORM DRAINS OPEN

Please remember to **move your vehicle on your street sweeping days.**

Vehicles parked on the street will block the sweepers and prevent them from keeping our storm drains clean of litter and leaves.

This pollutes our bay as storm drains flow directly to the bay.

For Parking Prohibited Street Sweeping Program Areas, follow the street sweeping hours on the posted signage.

When vehicles and other obstructions block the street, sweepers cannot remove debris against the curb.

A Word About Cardboard

Milpitas residents are doing a great job recycling, but cardboard is still frequently found in the garbage. All clean, dry cardboard belongs in the **blue recycling container** (yellow lid container/side, if applicable).



For properties with:

- **Split Cart or Dedicated Cart Service:** Flatten cardboard and cut large pieces to 3' x 3'. Place in the blue cart, on the **yellow side (for split carts) or with a yellow lid**. Extra cardboard should be flattened, cut, and stacked next to the cart.
- **Bin Service:** Flatten cardboard and place in the **blue paper/fiber bin**. DO NOT stack extra cardboard next to the bin.

Never place cardboard in the garbage, food scraps, recyclable containers, or yard trimmings.
