Guided phonics instruction helps students practice sounding out words and develop foundational reading skills.

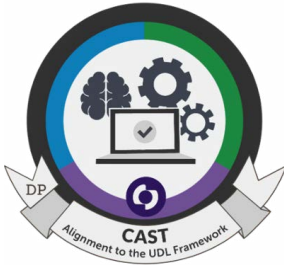
Sing-Along Mode (certain titles only)
