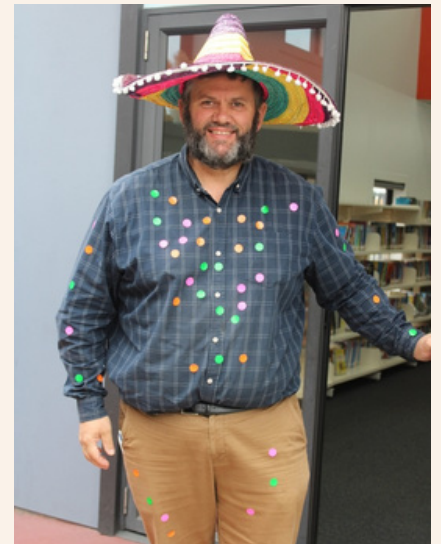
A huge well done to everyone who jumped in and gave it a go. Your participation made the day such a success. It was also wonderful to have so many parents come along to be a part of the day.

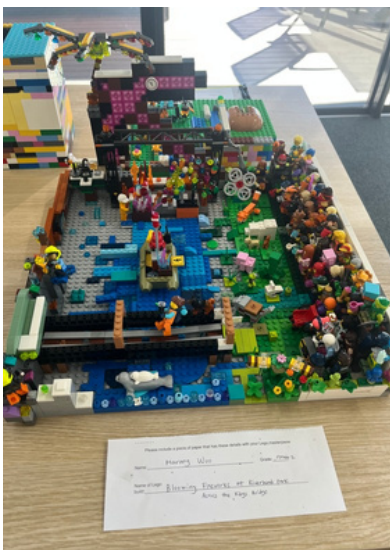
