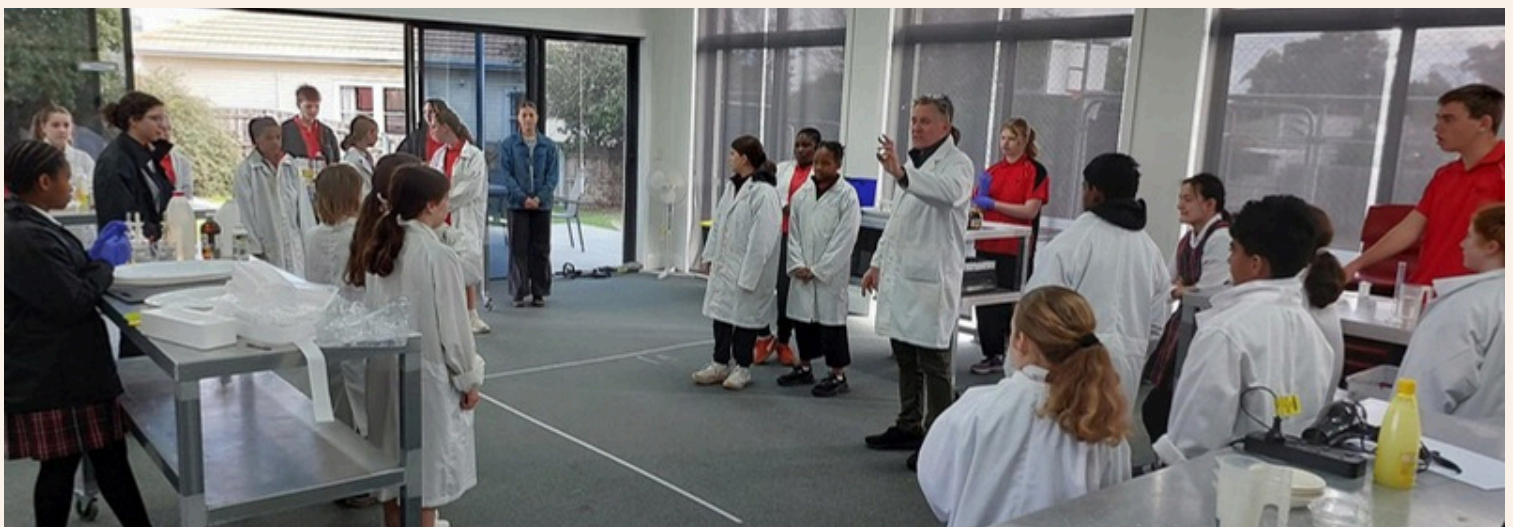


Science Week

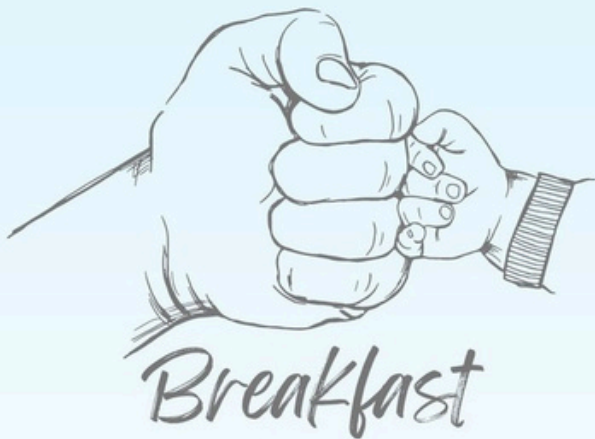
