WHEN SELLING / TRANSFERRING OWNERSHIP:

- Give the passport to the buyer / new owner at the time of the sale
- A record of the transfer of ownership of an equine shall be maintained by both the person transferring ownership and the person to whom ownership is transferred.

WHEN BUYING / ACQUIRING OWNERSHIP:

- You must receive the passport from the seller at the time of purchase.
- You must complete this transfer of ownership form.
- You must forward this form and the passport with the appropriate fee to the PIO within 30 days of taking ownership.

RECORDS / PENALTIES

- Both parties must keep a copy of this transfer of ownership declaration - photocopying or photo will suffice.
- DAFM authorised officers will carry out inspections and have powers to inspect records and documents.
- Failure to register the transfer of ownership within the time limit is now a serious offence in Ireland and attracts heavy penalties.
- Giving false, misleading or incomplete information is also a legal offence.

REGISTERED PREMISES:

- It is a legal requirement under the Control on Places where Horses are kept Regulation (SI 113 of 2014) that all premises where equines are kept must be registered with the Department of Agriculture. Accordingly, you should ensure that your equine is being kept on a registered premises. If your holding is not already registered as an Equine Premises, you should apply immediately to DAFM for an Equine Premises Registration Number. (**E.P.R.N.**).
- If you are based in Northern Ireland you must provide an Equine Establishment Number (**E.E.N.**). If your holding is not already registered for an E.E.N., you should apply immediately to DAERA.
- Please ensure the premises number provided accurately reflects the horse's location. The equine will be reported to DAFM as being located at the E.P.R.N. or E.E.N. provided on the application and added to the keepers/operators herd profile, confirming that the animal is under their care and control for regulatory, traceability and welfare purposes. Giving false or misleading information is a legal offence.
- Note: Weatherbys cannot process any application without a valid E.P.R.N for Southern Ireland keepers/operators or an E.E.N. for Northern Ireland keepers/operators

SECTION F - DECLARATION

Weatherbys respects the rights to privacy of all its clients. Weatherbys will need to use the information provided by you for its own internal administration and analysis.
