1. Name of the Institution: The name of this Institution is

3. Objectives of the Institute:- All the objectives of this Institute are as follows:-

1. The I Love Foundation, Jaisalmer will be a Secular, Non-Political, Employment-oriented, a service organization catering to every caste, class and all living beings of the society and the country.

2. National and Social Welfare Program - To facilitate the resolution of various problems faced by the disadvantaged and economically and socially backward people, women, Dalits, all types of differently-abled individuals, destitute, orphans, elderly, shaheeds, martyrs' widows, soldiers' dependents, Harijans, abandoned individuals, widows, and all types of patients, malnourished, victims of poverty, starvation and famine, malnourished and mentally challenged children, mental patients, neglected individuals, senior citizens, by establishing and managing old-age homes, orphanages, women's shelters, disabled shelters, housing facilities, hostels, and arranging for their rehabilitation. To establish and manage self-help groups and financial institutions and improve their living standards while assisting them to become self-reliant and working for their welfare and development by striving to acquire their rights, privileges, and amenities. To organize community marriage events for social upliftment, make efforts to eradicate various customs and practices like economic and social inequalities, caste divisions, gender disparities, racial discrimination, untouchability, bias, and prevailing corruption, adulteration, exploitation, dowry system, funeral feasts, child marriages, etc. in the society.



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
3. Promoting the ideals of national unity, integrity, peace, discipline, and fraternity among children, youth, students, and all sections of society, and fostering respect towards teachers, elders, and martyrs. Working towards the integration of sentiments that transcend caste, class, race, and language divisions, and striving to envision and create a meaningful, new clean society based on equality.

4. Disaster management program - Providing relief to affected individuals during various emergencies, natural or man-made disasters, and cooperating with the government and administration in disaster management. Implementing various government schemes and participating in national and international programs for the welfare of all living beings, society, and the nation. Engaging in activities that benefit the global population and promote public welfare.

5. In the field of medical and health - The organization aims to establish and operate programs for the prevention and eradication of diseases such as AIDS, leprosy, tuberculosis (TB), blindness, cancer, immunization, pulse polio, fluoride-free water, diabetes, hypertension, paralysis, stroke, malnutrition, and hunger. It will also work towards establishing and running programs for reproductive and child health, anganwadis, population control, maternity, and child welfare, and creating a drug-free society by establishing and managing de-addiction centers. The organization will raise awareness among people about various community services and all types of diseases and work towards their eradication and health protection. It will also establish and manage medical colleges and hospitals, provide high-quality healthcare services, and make efforts to organize various medical camps to provide free medical facilities.

6. Rural development, farmers, women, and agricultural development program - Establishing legal assistance centers to provide legal aid for economic and social justice for the poor and vulnerable individuals and raising awareness among people for cultural awakening and cultural awareness by organizing cultural programs, conferences (poetry symposiums, debate competitions, music events, plays, and dance competitions) from time to time. Conducting various competitions for overall development of students and nurturing talents. To assist in providing loans to unemployed through financial institutions and government schemes promoting self-employment. To assist/provide training in modern agricultural techniques to farmers and improving their economic and social status by increasing agricultural production and conserving natural resources in society.

7. Water Conservation Program - Implementing government schemes/ initiatives for environmental, land, and water conservation, providing clean drinking water supply to the general public, and participating in partnership and in the construction,



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


restoration of tanks/ponds in homes and development of rivers, ponds, dams, anicuts etc. on farmers' agricultural land and government land. Promoting awareness of water conservation and providing training in modern water conservation techniques. Encouraging and supporting water harvesting efforts and making various efforts for water conservation.

8. Women Empowerment Program - Establishing and operating schools, colleges, teacher training institutes, pharmacy, management, technical, and medical colleges, research institutes for the empowerment and educational upliftment of women. Creating awareness and promoting self-help groups and self-employment for economic and social self-reliance. Facilitating financial assistance and organizing various activities in a planned manner. Working towards gender equality, self-reliance, and various initiatives for women's empowerment/ upliftment in society.

9. Organizational Program - Establishing communication and co-ordination with various organizations to reach and serve the appropriate and needy people through developmental schemes operated by government, non-government, and social service institutions. Building public power and awareness against inequality, injustice, exploitation, and various types of pollutions and seeking and providing fair and peaceful solutions.

10. Cultural, Literary, and Artistic Development, Tourism Development Program - The organization will actively work towards the conservation of national heritage, historical buildings, monuments, and promoting cultural, literary, and artistic awareness. It aims to raise interest in literature, culture, and art among the people and provide appropriate recognition to artists in society by organizing plays, gatherings, exhibitions, short films, and publications of newspapers/magazines to promote traditional arts. The organization will establish film societies and support talented individuals by producing films and documentaries, placing them at appropriate positions in society. Efforts will be made to protect the human rights of foreign tourists visiting Indian cities and tourist destinations from various problems and difficulties such as harassment, begging, theft of their valuable items, etc. It will work towards preserving the glorious Indian historical and cultural tradition of "Atithi Devo Bhava" (the guest is like a god) and creating awareness among foreign tourists. And to make efforts for the reconstruction, restoration, beautification, and development of Indian tourist destinations and to elevate Indian tourism to new heights on the global stage, the organization will motivate people and seek support from various institutions, individuals, and administrative bodies to promote the tourism industry. It will organize camel safari campaigns and make every possible effort to promote tourism in Jaisalmer and throughout the country. The organization



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
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will collect cooperation funds from all tourism businesses to ensure proper cleanliness arrangements for the entire city. It will make continuous efforts to improve the extensive cleanliness system in Jaisalmer city. By involving as many people as possible in the cleanliness campaign, the organization will work towards obtaining the "World Class Heritage City" status for Jaisalmer. It will strive to find solutions to the difficulties faced by tourists visiting Jaisalmer city until the end of the year. It will warn tourists about people engaging in beggary and provide them with the right guidance. The organization will work towards freeing tourists from groups that harass them for alms in the Jaisalmer city area. It will caution them and provide proper guidance to avoid becoming victims of deception. The organization will strive to relieve tourists from groups that hassle them for alms in the Jaisalmer city area. It will alert them to safeguard their valuables such as purses, mobile phones, etc., from thieves and ensure that the police administration is informed about such individuals.

The organization will work towards resolving all kinds of noise pollution in tourist areas after 11:00 PM and seek the expected cooperation from the administration. Information about noise polluters will be communicated to the authorities. To maintain Jaisalmer's historical and cultural glorious tradition, the organization will seek the cooperation of all departments, private entrepreneurs, and non-governmental organizations involved in the development of the tourism industry and inspire their active participation by establishing coordination in their efforts. It will encourage and inspire the active participation of the state and central government and administration in finding solutions and management of problems related to the tourism industry and implementing various government schemes for tourism development. The organization will also participate in the implementation of national and international programs for tourism development and represent the institution in such initiatives.

11. In the field of environmental conservation - Conserving natural resources (water, forests, air, land), promoting environmental protection, advocating and developing alternative energy resources, managing declining/ falling water levels in land, working on sustainable methods for barren land utilization, establishing nurseries and promoting more tree plantations, conserving endangered plant species, creating an environment for tree planting awareness in society, ensuring their safety through public awareness, and creating awareness and efforts to address all types of pollution including water, forests, air, land, and noise pollution. For maintaining environmental balance and conservation on Earth, the organization will establish solar and wind energy plants to promote the use of renewable energy resources and



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explore various methods and solutions. It will also seek public cooperation and promote the cleanliness campaign in society and establish a healthy and clean society.

12. The program for animal conservation - Involves protecting all types of animals and birds, establishing and managing cow shelters/ Gau-Shalas, providing financial assistance and various forms of support to different cow shelters/ Gau-Shalas. It also includes identifying and managing the protection of endangered species, establishing and running animal hospitals, veterinary colleges, and animal health camps, making efforts to stop animal killings, and creating awareness and consciousness among people to shift towards vegetarianism from non-vegetarianism. The program aims at the care, safety, and upliftment of animals.

13. The program for Interfaith Harmony/ Programs for Equal Respect for All Religions - Involves constructing, assisting, and renovating religious centers of all faiths, spreading the message of "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" (the world is one family), promoting service to all living beings, building character, and spreading the essence of human values in society. It also includes engaging in spiritual activities, creating awareness among the general public about their duties towards the nation, and fostering a sense of mutual cooperation.

14. In the field of Education - Providing high-quality education, special education, and comprehensive development programs for underprivileged students, students from marginalized communities, persons with disabilities, children, elderly, and women, and promoting self-employment through vocational education to make them self-reliant. Promoting education through the integration of global knowledge, establishing and managing various levels of schools, coaching institutes, higher education universities, academic and technical institutions, management, professional, modern science, and all types of medical education institutions, engineering institutions, and research institutes, universities, various training centers, libraries, and reading rooms. Strive to promote and support bringing new talents forward. Providing means of livelihood, connecting more and more people from all sections of society, and empowering women. Encouraging and promoting girls' education.

15. In the realm of Physical, Mental, Human, Social, and Cultural Development, as well as Sports and Physical Development - Promoting physical, mental, and human development, as well as establishing and instilling cultural values among the youth and women who are immersed in the fast-paced western lifestyle in the economic era. Providing training to the youth and women for physical and mental development through various attention, yoga, and spiritual

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programs and competitions at the state, national, and international levels. Also, fostering respect, honor, and human values towards elders and relationships, towards religions, Indian social, and cultural values, and traditions among rural and urban youth and women. Making various efforts to establish rural sports, national, and international recognition for Paralympic, Olympic, Asian Games, and all types of sports for the development of rural and urban sports. Providing training to the youth and women and organizing various competitions at the state, national, and international levels to nurture and encourage rural and urban talents and to achieve recognition at the state, national, and international levels.

16. 4. Membership

The following eligibility criteria have been set for individuals to become members of the Society/ Institution/ Organization.

- (1) Reside in the Society's/ Institution's/ Organization's operational area.
- (2) Be of legal age (adult).
- (3) Not be mentally ill or insane.
- (4) Have an interest in and faith in the objectives of the Society/ Institution/ Organization.
- (5) Prioritize the welfare of the Society/ Institution/ Organization.



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5. Categorization of Membership

The following categories of individuals can become members of the Society/ Institution/ Organization:

- (1) President - To be elected.
- (2) Vice-President - To be elected.
- (3) Treasurer - To be elected.
- (4) Mantri/Secretary - To be elected.
- (5) General Members - To be elected.

6. Fees and Donations by Members

Under Sub-Rule No. 4, the members will be required to pay the following fees and donations:

Annual fees must be deposited within 30 days from the election date, and monthly fees must be deposited on the 1st day of the English month.

1. President - Amount: 11,000/- annually or 1,000/- monthly.
2. Vice-President - Amount: 11,000/- annually or 1,000/- monthly.
3. Treasurer - Amount: 11,000/- annually or 1,000/- monthly.
4. Mantri/Secretary - Amount: 11,000/- annually or 1,000/- monthly.
5. General Members - Must deposit Amount: 100/- monthly and obtain a receipt after paying the membership fee.

7. Termination of Membership

Termination/End of Membership of Members of the Society/ Institution/ Organization can be done in the following manner:

(a) In the event of death, insanity, or voluntary resignation.

(b) If a member remains absent continuously for three consecutive general meetings of the Society/ Institution/ organization, it will be deemed as their membership from all positions will automatically be considered terminated/ended. Upon being absent for three consecutive general meetings, the concerned member will be informed, and in the fourth month general meeting, their termination from the positions within the Society/ Institution/ Organization will be decided.



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The confirmation of this decision will be made in the subsequent meeting of the Society/ Institution/ Organization, and any appeal made after confirmation will not be accepted.

(c) If a member fails to deposit the membership fee of the Society/ Institution/ Organization continuously for three months, it will be deemed as their membership from all positions will automatically be considered terminated/ended. Upon being failure to deposit the membership fee of the Society/ Institution/ Organization continuously for three months, the concerned member will be informed, and in the fourth month in the general meeting, their termination from the positions within the Society/ Institution/ Organization will be decided/ Finalized. The confirmation of this decision will be made in the subsequent meeting of the Society/ Institution/ Organization, and any appeal made after confirmation will not be accepted.

(d) If a member performs actions against the objectives of the Society/ Institution/ Organization.

(e) If found guilty by the Executive Committee.

Appeals for the termination mentioned above of membership will be considered valid only if submitted in writing within 15 days from the date of termination before the confirmation of the decision in the fourth month's general meeting. The decision taken by the majority in the general meeting will be final, and appeals made after confirmation will not be considered valid.

8. General Assembly

The General Assembly of the Society/ Institution will be formed by all the members mentioned in Sub-rule 5 of the Society/ Institution.

9. Powers and Duties of the General Assembly

The General Assembly will have the following rights and duties:

(a) Conducting elections for the Executive Committee.


(b) Approval of the annual budget of the Society/ Institution.

(c) Reviewing and approving the activities carried out by the Executive Committee.

(d) Making changes, modifications, or amendments to the Society's/ Institution's funds, office, objectives, and constitution with a two-thirds majority of all members of the Society/ Institution.

10. Meetings of the General Assembly

1. The meetings of the General Assembly: Such meetings will be organized by the office bearers of the Executive Committee and nominated general members. These meetings may also be conducted through telephonic or oral communication for the benefit of the Society/ Institution, provided that the presence of two-thirds of the



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office bearers of the Executive Committee and nominated general members is mandatory.

1. It is mandatory to hold one General Assembly meeting annually. However, in case of necessity, a Special General Assembly may be called by the Chairman/President/ Secretary at any time.

2. The quorum for the General Assembly meeting will be two-thirds of the total members.

3. Notice of the meeting will be given 7 days in advance, and in case of an urgent meeting, the notice will be given 3 days in advance. (The notice of the meeting may be given in written/oral/telephone communication, which will be considered valid, and only the written notice will be understood/considered).

4. In the absence of a quorum, the meeting may be postponed, and it can be rescheduled at the same place and time after 7 days' notice. In such a postponed meeting, quorum will not be required, but only the matters that were on the previous agenda will be discussed.

5. If half or 10 members, whichever is less of the Society/ Institution apply in writing for a meeting, the Chairman/President/ Secretary will be obligated to call a meeting within one month. In case the President/Minister fails to convene the meeting within the specified period, any three members from the mentioned 10 members can issue a notice, and all decisions taken in such a meeting will be legally valid and binding.

(The notice of the meeting may be given through oral/ telephone/ letter/ UPC/ post or newspaper publication.)

11. Formation of the Executive Committee

To run the Society's/ Institution's work efficiently, a Management Committee will be formed, consisting of the following office bearers and members:

President - 1

Vice- President - 1

Treasurer - 1

Mantri/Secretary - 1

General Member - 3

(If any other positions or designations are changed, mention them here. If you want to reduce the number, you may do so.)

Thus, the Management Committee will have a total of 7 members, including office bearers and General members.



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12. Election of the Executive Committee

- A. The election of the Management Committee will be conducted by the General Assembly for a term of two years.
- B. The election will be conducted through direct/indirect voting system.
- C. The appointment of the election officer will be done by the Management Committee.

13. Powers and Duties of the Executive Committee


The Management Committee of the Society/ Institution will have the following rights and responsibilities:

- a. Appointing and terminating members/membership.
- b. Preparing the annual budget of the Society/ Institution.
- c. Ensuring the security of the Society's/ Institution's assets.
- d. Appointing, dismissing, and determining the salaries of contractual employees.
- e. Implementing decisions passed by the General Assembly.
- f. Forming sub-committees for organizational purposes.
- g. Undertaking other activities for the benefit of the institution.

14. Meetings of the Executive Committee

The meetings of the Management Committee will be exclusively held by the Executive committee members. Such meetings can be conducted via telephone or verbally, as deemed necessary for essential matters, with at least 2/3 of the Quorum/ Committee members present to decide on issues.

1. The Management Committee/Executive Committee must hold a minimum of 5 meetings annually, but additional meetings can be convened when required by the Chairman/Secretary.
2. The quorum for the meetings will be more than half the total number of members of the Management Committee.
3. Notice of the meeting will usually be provided seven days in advance, and for other essential meetings, it can be given in less time through oral/telephone communication.
4. In the absence of a quorum, the meeting can be adjourned and reconvened at the specified place and time on the next day. In such an adjourned meeting, a quorum will not be required, but the matters for consideration will remain the same as in the previous agenda. The presence of at least two office bearers of the managing committee, in addition to the attending members,



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will be mandatory in such an adjourned meeting. The proceedings of this postponed meeting must be ratified in the next General Assembly.

(The notice of the meeting may be given through oral/ telephone/ letter/ UPC/ post or newspaper publication.)

15. Powers and Duties of the Executive Committee Members

The rights and responsibilities of the Management Committee of the Society/ Institution are as follows:

President:


1. Chairing and conducting meetings.
2. Casting the deciding vote in case of a tie.
3. Convening meetings.
4. Representing the Society/ Institution.
5. Signing contracts and other legal documents on behalf of the Society/ Institution.
6. Other tasks for the benefit of the Society/ Institution.

Vice- President:

1. Acting in place of the Chairman in their absence and exercising all their powers.
2. Utilizing other Powers/ Authorities given by the Management Committee.

Mantri/Secretary:

1. Convening meetings.
2. Writing and maintaining records of proceedings.
3. Managing and controlling the administration, finance, organization, and implementation of the Society/ Institution.
4. Managing the Society's/ Institution's bank accounts and overseeing income and expenditure.
5. Handling correspondence on behalf of the Society/ Institution.
6. Signing contracts and other legal documents.
7. Controlling the service rules, salary determination, appointments and terminations of the Society's/ Institution's contractual employees, as well as approving their salaries and travel bills.
8. Implementing decisions taken by the Society/ Institution and arranging necessary resources for them.
9. Decentralizing activities for the discharge of duties.
10. Representing the Society/ Institution and signing legal documents on behalf



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11. of the Society/ Institution.
12. Co-operating with other Societies/ Institutions with similar objectives.
13. Performing other necessary legal tasks for the security of the Society's/ Institution's property and undertaking other assigned tasks.

Treasurer:

1. Prepare the annual financial statements.
2. Maintain control over daily financial transactions.
3. Receive and provide receipts for donations, fees, grants, etc.
4. Accomplish other assigned tasks.

16. Society's/ Institution's Fund

The Society's/ institution's funds will be collected in the following manner:

1. Donation/Contributions
2. Fees
3. Grants
4. Financial Assistance: Financial assistance for fulfilling the objectives of the Society/ Institution can be received from Individuals, Organizations within the country as well as Foreign sources/ companies through donations, Foreign funding through FCRA, fees, and grants, assistance, and fees. In addition to this, support can also be sought or taken from the company's CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) programs of the organization's management committee, nominated ordinary members, and any other interested companies or firms.
5. Government Grants.

A- The funds collected in the above manner will be kept secure in a nationalized/cooperative bank.

B- Withdrawals or transactions from the bank can be made with the joint signatures of any two of authorized officials, such as the Chairman, Mantri/Secretary, or Treasurer.

17. Special Rights Related to Funds

For the Society's/ institution's benefit and as per the necessity of work and time, the following authorized officials can agree on a specific amount for the Society/ institution:

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1. Chairman - As per the requirement - Amount in Rupees.
2. Treasurer - As per the requirement - Amount in Rupees.
3. Mantri/Secretary - As per the requirement - Amount in Rupees.

The approval of the above-mentioned amount will be obtained from the Management Committee. The appointment of an auditor will be done by the Management Committee.

18. Audit of the Society/ Institution

The complete annual audit of all the accounts of the institution will be conducted, and the annual accounts will be submitted to the Registrar and other relevant authorities each year.

The financial year of the institution will be from 1st April to 31st March.

19. Amendments and Modifications in the Institution's Constitution

As per the requirements specified in the constitution of the institution, any changes, additions, or modifications to the General Assembly can be made with a two-thirds majority of the members, in accordance with Section 12 of the Rajasthan Registration Act of 1958.

20. Dissolution of the Society/ Institution

In the event of the institution's dissolution, all movable and immovable assets of the institution will be transferred to other institutions with similar objectives, in accordance with Sections 13 and 14 of the Rajasthan Registration Act of 1958.

21. Inspection of the Society's/ Institution's Accounts

The Registrar, Societies, Jaisalmer, will have full authority over inspecting the records and accounts of the institution, and their suggestions will be duly considered and implemented.
