New Way International Limited is committed to achieving **Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050**, in line with UK Government policy and the requirements of **PPN 06/21**. We are taking active steps to reduce our environmental impact across our operations, supply chain, and service delivery.

This represents a **12.5% reduction** from our 2024 baseline.

## Carbon Reduction Measures

### Measures implemented since 2024

- Transition to **100% renewable electricity** in all office locations
- Adoption of a **remote-first working model** to reduce commuting emissions
- Reduction in business travel and prioritization of **virtual meetings**
- Procurement of **energy-efficient IT equipment**
- Increased recycling and waste-reduction initiatives
- Engagement with suppliers to encourage **lower-carbon logistics**

### Planned future measures

- Strengthening **sustainable procurement standards**
- Transition to **electric vehicles** for any future fleet requirements
- Further optimization of cloud and data usage to reduce energy intensity
- Annual sustainability training for all staff
- Introduction of a supplier carbon-impact assessment
