- **Grant Review & Due Diligence:** Support the evaluation of grant proposals for scientific merit, innovation, feasibility, and alignment with BFI priorities. Help coordinate peer review processes, assist with scientific due diligence, and support leadership in funding decision making.
- **Data Collection & Analysis:** Assist in collecting and analysing data from internal systems, external databases, surveys, and market reports. Support tracking of global and national trends in biomedical R&D, emerging technologies, startups, and industry research to generate insights for program planning.

- **Stakeholder Engagement & Partnerships:** Help identify, coordinate, and maintain relationships with stakeholders across the biomedical innovation ecosystem. Support senior team members in facilitating collaborations, identifying shared research interests, and enabling joint initiatives.
