

# Customize your video layout view in Webex


Whether you're a Webex meeting host, co-host, or participant, you can customize your meeting or event video layout to focus on the people and content that's important to you.

With the ability to customize your video stage layout, you can easily switch from vertical to horizontal filmstrips, display participants' names, set presenters or shared content as the stage focus, and more. For example, use the zoom feature to focus on the decision maker in a sales meeting. Educators can place their video beside shared content for better student retention. A meeting host can pin a sign language interpreter to the stage to ensure accessibility compliance. With a wide array of options, customizing your stage layout in Webex can help you keep better track of what's going on.

## Change your layout in Webex

There are lots of different ways to manage your layout.

- Click **Layout** to change your view. Choose between:
  - Grid view is the easy way to divide your attention across many speakers in a large meeting. In grid view, use the slider to set the number of users in your view.
  - Stack view and side-by-side put shared content or the active speaker on stage for a more focused view.
  - Select full-screen view to maximize your screen space, float content panels, and get the most from multiple monitors.
- Click and drag users from the filmstrip to the stage, then click the pin to keep them there.
- The host has the option to set the stage view for all participants.
