## Everything is extra with Microsoft licensing

With Microsoft, everything is EXTRA, and nothing is free!

- ✗ Complicated setup requires expensive Certified professional help
- ✗ Pricing is not transparent! The way Microsoft 365 is bundled, the add-on costs creep up quickly. The following features are add-ons for additional cost:
  - Phone system
  - Phone Plan (domestic & international)
  - Cloud video per device
  - Azure AD
- ✗ Teams Premium is an additional \$7/u/m for
  - Intelligent Meeting Recap
  - Intelligent Call Recap
  - Watermark Meetings
  - End-to-End Encryption
- ✗ Copilot is an additional \$30/u/m for table stakes AI functionality
  - Catch me Up in Meetings
  - Chat Summarization
  - Rewrite messages

## Poor Integration Experience with other applications

Complicated deployments get in the way of using all the features as they are designed. MSFT Teams only supports one-way integration, meaning you cannot run MSFT Teams inside other apps, you can only run other apps inside MSFT Teams, limiting your options. Webex offers bi-directional integrations making it easier for users to work in a way that is best for them.

✗ **MSFT Teams and Office 365 Do Not Work Well Together:** Webex is better at O365 integration than MSFT Teams. We make it simple to share documents, MSFT Teams makes it frustrating, and users resort to 3rd party products increasing cost and security issues.

✗ **File Storage Options:** Without OneDrive for Business, MSFT Teams has nowhere to store files in the Messaging feature. And if SharePoint integration isn't complete for all users, you will have content duplication, confusion, and version control problems leading to..."where did my files go?"

✗ **Seamless Collaboration:** For the IT adventurous, MSFT does not support open APIs. Collaboration must happen through Teams. Unlike Webex, Teams can't be embedded into other apps, including MSFT Apps!

## Microsoft Teams lets calling suffer

Missing fundamental business calling features:

- ✗ No Noise Removal for PSTN Calls
- ✗ No Hunt Groups
- ✗ No Group VM
- ✗ No Selective Call Forwarding
- ✗ No Business Continuity (Call forward not reachable)
- ✗ No Selective Call Rejection


Basic Customer Experience gaps:

- ✗ No weighted, Priority, or Skills based routing for call queues
- ✗ No Call Back option for call queues
- ✗ Only Standard greetings and Hold music for call queues
- ✗ No bounce call policies for call queues
- ✗ No routing policy for stranded calls

Microsoft Teams

## MSFT Teams is simple to configure and manage

An entire consulting industry exists to support MSFT apps! MSFT Teams has a very complex deployment. Default settings are not optimized for the best user experience or security. Administrators need to use MSFT Teams Admin Center, Power Shell, and a 3<sup>rd</sup> party portal to configure calling and phones. Webex default settings are optimized out of the box for interoperability, end points, & guests and don't require anything to maximize your employee and guest experiences. Webex is managed via Control Hub, a centralized portal for calling, messaging, meetings, analytics, and troubleshooting.

## We've looked at MSFT Teams and it looks less expensive

To access Calling, Messaging, Meetings, with Microsoft you need Teams, Teams Phone, PSTN, and Power Bi. For AI features, you must add on CoPilot or Teams Premium or BOTH depending on your needs. In contrast, [SP Product Name] with Webex offers a straightforward subscription with more standard features including AI, analytics, security and compliance, all included. Plus, you can still integrate your Microsoft Outlook and documents with Webex.

## Microsoft includes security & compliance capabilities

Security and compliance are crucial for businesses. Microsoft requires add-ons like Teams Premium for watermarking and end-to-end encryption of meetings, or higher packages with Microsoft Purview for key compliance capabilities of customizable retention policies and eDiscovery. In contrast, Cisco's Webex has built-in security, offering end-to-end encryption across all packages without extra cost. Webex also includes ProPack for customizable data retention policies and compliance officer capabilities, and eDiscovery.

## I don't want to switch my devices to Cisco

You don't have to! Webex Calling integrates with an unmatched set of intelligent audio and video devices, delivering functionality, quality, control, and security that enterprises expect and demand and providing a truly complete collaboration experience

Microsoft Teams only runs on select certified devices, meaning you will likely need to buy new devices that are capable of running the Microsoft Teams software.

## My MS Teams is grandfathered in and not extra

Microsoft announced the unbundling of MS Teams from its various 365 licenses in April of 2024. While Microsoft has stated customers will be able to renew their current plans, they have made no public commitment to honor existing pricing.

## MS Teams phone has call queues I can use for customer experience.

A 2024 Hubspot survey shows that 82% of customers expect immediate resolution. MS Teams call queues lack essential features such as weighted, priority, and skills-based routing, as well as bounced call policies and routing for stranded calls. Additionally, there is no callback option, forcing callers to stay on hold without comfort messages. Webex calling plans include all these features, ensuring timely issue resolution.

# Product gaps

## Calling

MSFT Teams is missing key features in calling such as: hunt groups, group voicemail, noise removal for PSTN calls and several call forwarding features which gives you the impression that MSFT has not yet built a full PBX replacement. The initial low-cost appearance is deceiving. Many Teams Phone and PSTN must be added to have a bare bones business calling solution. MSFT Teams calling in one word: expensive.

## Meetings

MSFT Teams makes you pay more to use AI with Microsoft 365 Copilot at a price tag of \$30 per user per month and Teams Premium if you need end-to-end meeting encryption, adding cost and configuration complexity.

## Messaging

MSFT Teams 'chat' vs 'channels' confuse users with separate feeds, different tabs, and notifications turned off by default. MSFT Teams 'channels' are not intuitive, with confusion stemming from disconnects with Active Directory 'groups' making it difficult to find work in progress. And if you want to use AI to be more efficient in MSFT you have to pay more to get Copilot.




