LET'S JUMP IN

Looking to spend a summer using your skills to serve cross-culturally?

Mexico City is the largest city in Latin America, with approximately 27 million people in the metropolitan area. The State of Mexico (EdoMex) is home to 17 million of that population and wraps around two sides of Mexico City. The greater Metropolitan area, formed by Mexico City and EdoMex where our summer program is hosted, is an important and strategic location for ministry outreach and church planting.

As a Mesa Intern in the Avance Mexico program, you'll be immersed in cross-cultural ministry and primarily focused on church planting with opportunities to be involved in: evangelism, discipleship, home groups, English classes, music classes, worship leading, open-air children's ministry, youth and college ministry, sports ministry, community development, and more.

Week in the life

Every week on the field is different! But here are some rhythms to expect each week of your summer internship.

- Worship at a local church 1-3 times per week
- Serve alongside Mexican ministries 3-5 times per week
- Language classes and tutoring 2-3 times per week
- Avance training and spiritual formation 1-2 times per week
- Language and cultural learning Continually through the immersion experience
- Sabbath 1 day per week

Living & Weekly Rhythms



What will the church placement be like?

You'll serve under local church leadership and alongside global workers in one of two placements:

- 1. A network of churches across five neighborhoods in northern Mexico City that collaborate in church planting and outreach.
- 2. A medium-sized church in an under-resourced neighborhood in southeastern Mexico City.

The northern church plants are located in large housing developments that function like urban villages, home to many young families who, unlike their parents, have little or no religious background—creating a spiritual environment that can be described as "urban agnostic." One church in the network also offers opportunities in community development through gardening and aquaponics.

The southeastern church has a high percentage of young adults and operates a vibrant community center that offers classes to engage kids, teens, and adults. A new coffee shop is also being launched to deepen connections with the neighborhood and within the church community.





Where will I live?

All of our interns live with Mexican host families in houses and apartments throughout the State of Mexico or Mexico City. Interns will be placed with families that may have young, adult or no children. Sometimes the houses may be very small, but the families are warm and hospitable.

How do you decide which ministry I'll be placed at?

For the summer program, you'll be assigned to a specific local church, but one day each week, you'll be given the opportunity to serve in different ministries to see where your passion lies and where the needs are greatest. You will also be exposed through cultural outings to different aspects of Mexican history and culture.

What do program costs include?

The program cost covers all your living expenses during your time in Mexico. This includes food, educational material and rent. Airfare is not included, but it is recommended you raise extra funds for this.



Language Learning



Do I need to know Spanish beforehand?

Although it is important to speak the language to be able to communicate effectively, it's okay if you do not know Spanish before serving in Mexico! All participants will be placed in semi-private tutoring or small group Spanish classes according to their level. Since Spanish is the heart language of Mexicans, we expect our interns to dedicate themselves to learning the language and ministering in Spanish.



How will I learn Spanish?

Throughout the summer, you will be placed in a beginner, intermediate, or advanced level Spanish class with the other interns. You will have plenty of time to practice by speaking with your host family & serving at your ministries.



Safety & Healthcare



Are the State of Mexico and Mexico City safe?

Mexico City is the largest city in Latin America and one of the largest cities in the world so naturally it has the problems of crime and corruption that abound in any large city. These problems can be worse at night and some areas are known to be more dangerous than others. However, the host families are experts on their neighborhoods and will be your best guides for what is safe and prudent. The important thing is to be careful and exercise common-sense precautions. As Christians, we look at the crime problem as both a danger to avoid and as evidence of the city's deep need for the gospel.

We're happy to respond to any questions you have. Although there are risks involved in any overseas assignment, and specifically here in Mexico, we can confidently say, that our participant's safety is of high importance for us.



What does Avance Mexico do to ensure safety?

Over the last 50 years of the Avance program, we've continually assessed risk & adjusted to ensure we have safety precautions in place to keep participants safe. These are all reviewed during the orientation that takes place during the first three days of the program.
