LET'S JUMP IN

Looking to spend 8 weeks using your skills to serve cross-culturally?

Servant Partners serves in the southeast of Mexico City, with ministry sites in Chimalhuacán, and Los Reyes La Paz. These communities face poverty, family disintegration, and limited opportunities, yet they are also vibrant centers where the Spirit of God is at work. Our locations are strategic hubs for holistic ministry, evangelism, and church planting in the greater Mexico City region.

As a Mesa Intern with Servant Partners, you will be immersed in cross-cultural ministry and holistic mission. You'll have the opportunity to serve in a wide range of ministries, including children's and youth clubs, community of arts (music classes, guitar, keyboard, vocal training, theater, dance, and drawing), sports ministry, traumainformed and healing groups, discipleship groups, Bible studies, evangelism, worship and community. You will grow in humility, deepen your biblical and theological understanding of mission, and develop practical ministry skills by walking alongside local leaders and families in contexts of vulnerability.

SUMMER INTERN

Week in the life

Every week on the field is different! But here are some rhythms to expect each week of your summer internship.

- Worship at a local church 2 times per week
- Bible Study/ discipleship programs 2 times per week
- Training and spiritual formation 2 times per week
- Kids/youth clubs & Communities of arts 3 times per week total
- Language class and tutoring 1 time a week
- Sabbath 1 day per week

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need to know Spanish beforehand?

Basic Spanish is helpful but not mandatory. Language acquisition is part of the immersion experience.

What do program costs include?

The program cost covers all your living expenses during your time in Mexico. This includes food, educational material and rent. Airfare is not included, but it is recommended you raise extra funds for this.

Mow will I spend my time as an intern?

Outside of trainings, interns also receive local ministry assignments, practice spiritual disciplines (e.g. Sabbath, prayer, silence and solitude), engage in peer accountability, and receive regular mentoring. The internship experience is designed to help interns grow in their connection with God, with each other, and with the poor. It is a powerful, life-changing time for maturing in your faith and discerning next steps in serving alongside the marginalized.

Where will I live?

Interns will live with Mexican host families (trusted Christian families), warm and hospitable

Is the area safe?

While Chimalhuacán presents urban challenges, we have been ministering in this community for over a decade and have established strict safety protocols developed over a decade of ministry which include:

- Clear movement protocols: No solo travel. Interns always go in pairs or with staff.
- Nighttime restrictions: Interns return to base before dark unless in supervised events.
- Regular check-ins: Interns check in with the team and have local emergency contacts.
- Medical access: Clinics and hospitals are accessible within 15–30 minutes.
- Cultural orientation: Interns receive training in cultural sensitivity, safety, and contextual ministry.

No region is risk-free, but with humility, caution, and prayer, interns can minister safely and meaningfully.
