District Reports:

District 1: Marie has moved to a PO position. They are seeing a lot of cocaine use, committing more kids. More people crimes vs substance crimes. More mental health and behavioral problems. They are utilizing there new K-9 in schools and creating a substance abuse education school program.

District 2: More juvenile commitments.

District 3: Washington County: “Washington County has received a \$9000 grant through the LOR Foundation to supplement our hygiene pantry and start a clothing pantry. We have the pantries mostly set up with shelving, storage bins, and a dressing area. We are currently in the process of purchasing items for both the hygiene and clothing pantries. We intend on utilizing both by the beginning of August. Hopefully we will be fully stocked before then! It's been a fun project and we hope to serve a lot of kids in our communities with new clothing and hygiene products!”

Canyon County:

Jose Orozco was announced as Director of Juvenile Probation in April 2026. Effective Monday, May 11th, Linda Hall was appointed Assistant Director of Juvenile Probation.

Nampa DJC:

No longer have a female program, all males. The females will go to St. Anthony due to staffing issues.

District 4: More mental health than substance abuse problems – person crimes vs. substance crimes. Partnering with schools on truancy. Diversion moving out of the probation department as of 6/1/26. They will be located all in one place.

District 5: Nothing new. Need a District 5 representative.

District 6: Children’s Mental Health brought in the Rock Heart Guy. Parent consent law is causing confusion due to the 860 house bill creating little clarification. Ask State Board of Education to teach teachers to know the difference between MH and substance use. Teach on drug trends and Mental Health. Language barrier identified in Power County due to higher Hispanic population. More

problems with truancy. New Power County PO going to P.O.S.T in June, Matt Olsen retired as director of Juvenile Probation.

District 7: Jefferson County has a new Judge, Judge Trent Belnap and Custer County has Judge Andrews. Lemhi County has a bunch of diversion kids doing burglaries, sending inappropriate images over phone, disobeying parents. Young kids age 9 are getting Diversion. Custer County is excited to have their new judge.

Tribal: About 2 months ago, their prosecutor resigned and the other one's contract wasn't extended. The child support prosecutor is the interim prosecutor. Chief Judge position open. Low caseload for juveniles. Good things for Youth has been going into the schools recruiting for Flagging and construction laborers, New PO in Coeur d' Alene Tribe.

Floating Reps: Nothing new

June 11 will have an E-Board meeting at 8:30. There will be a few people absent from the meeting due to other obligations but will keep the date. Will send updates.
