We need your assistance to help make this goal a reality.

What we are proposing for your **school** are the following:

1. Five (5) RPJ branded 55gallon bins on your compound, in an accessible area, for the collection of plastic bottles.
2. One or two RPJ super sacks for temporary storage of these bagged bottles, to be collected and exchanged/replaced once filled.

RPJ's responsibilities

1. We will provide you with branded recycling receptacle(s) for the collection of plastic bottles only for the location(s) identified.
2. We will collect the packaged bottles as soon as the receptacle(s) is/are filled.
3. We will promote your school as a drop off location for persons in your community.
4. We will provide the necessary notices for public education and awareness.
