- flattened corrugated cardboard (NO WAXED CARDBOARD OR FROZEN FOOD BOXES)
- cereal, cracker, soda & beer cartons, paper egg cartons, paper towel tubes



PLASTIC REMOV

REMOVE CAPS/LIDS & RINSE CLEAN

- plastic bottles, tubs (6 oz or larger)
- rigid plastic containers (such as yogurt and margarine tubs)
- rigid plastic plant pots (4" or larger)
- · plastic buckets (5 gal or less)
- · plastic milk jugs

TIN & REMOVE CAPS/LIDS & RINSE CLEAN ALUMINUM

- . cans, labels okay
- · foil, pie tins & trays
- · beverage cans

- PLASTIC BAGS are not recyclable at the curb. Please recycle at participating grocery stores. Visit PlasticFilmRecycling.org for more information.
- **RIGID** plastic clamshells, hard plastics from produce or bakery items are not acceptable in your Blue Roll cart. Please dispose of trash.
- * **STYROFOAM** is not recyclable. Please bag before disposing as trash. Most mailing services will accept clean, bagged Styrofoam peanuts.
- . GLASS not recyclable
